3.5.2 Student Government Tuition Waivers

In acknowledgement of their service to Joliet Junior College and the time commitment necessary to perform the functions of their respective offices, the Student Government President and the Student Government Vice President will each be provided with a tuition waiver for an amount equal to the cost of tuition for up to 12 credit hours per semester. Students will receive the tuition waiver for the semester(s) in which they serve and for the number of credit hours for which they are registered. Students who receive financial aid may have the award adjusted based on their aid.

Tuition waivers will be awarded to eligible students at the end of each semester in which they serve. Criteria include successfully completing the coursework for which they are registered, maintaining a 2.5 grade point average, fulfilling the duties of the position and attending all mandatory meetings. The waiver will be processed after a review of job performance, course completion and grade point average at the end of each semester of service.

Student Government Tuition Waivers are intended to engender interest in these important student leadership positions. The waivers also make this service possible for students for whom the time and effort required by these positions - in addition to their academic coursework - may preclude work for pay outside the institution.
