

Background

The U.S. Department of Education (ED) requires institutions that participate in the student financial assistance programs authorized under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (the HEA), to report certain information about students who enrolled in Title IV-eligible educational programs that lead to “Gainful Employment” in a recognized occupation (GE programs).

Gainful Employment (GE) programs for public and domestic nonprofit institutions include the following:

- Non-degree programs, including all certificate programs. Certificate programs include undergraduate certificate programs, post-baccalaureate certificate programs, graduate certificate programs, and postgraduate certificate programs. Note that awarding students one or more certificates as part of a degree program does not create GE programs based upon the awarding of the certificate(s).
- Teacher certification programs, including both programs that result in a certificate awarded by the institution and those where the institution itself does not provide a certificate but which consist of a collection of course work necessary for the student to receive a State professional teaching credential or certification.
- Approved "Comprehensive Transition Programs" for students with intellectual disabilities.

The following are not considered Gainful Employment programs:

- Programs that lead to a degree, including associate's degrees, bachelor's degrees, graduate degrees, and professional degrees.
- Programs that are at least two years in length that are fully transferable to a bachelor's degree program.
- Preparatory courses of study that provide course work necessary for enrollment in an eligible program.

The following is a summary of the information that must be disclosed by an institution (JJC) for each of its GE Programs, as well as, the date for disclosure under the new regulation.

- The name and U.S. Department of Labor's Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) code of the occupations that the program prepares students to enter, along with links to occupational profiles on the U.S. Department of Labor's O*NET Web site or its successor site - *July 1, 2011.*
- The on-time graduation rate for students completing the program - *July 1, 2011.*
- The tuition and fees the institution charges a student for completing the program within normal time - *July 1, 2011.*
- The typical costs for books and supplies (unless those costs are included as part of tuition and fees), and the cost of room and board, if applicable – *July, 2011.*
- The job placement rate for students completing the program – *July 1, 2011.*
- The median loan debt incurred by students who completed the program (separately by Title IV loans and by other educational debt to include both private educational loans and institutional financing) as provided by the Secretary – *October 1, 2011.*
- Other information the Secretary provided to the institution about the program.

The following questions were used for each award certificate to determine whether the program at Joliet Junior College is a GE program. Special attention was paid to programs that lead to an associate's degree. Any program certificate that would ultimately lead to an A.A.S. at JJC is not currently being considered a GE Program. The analysis conducted resulted in thirteen (13) programs that meet the GE criteria. The programs that meet the criteria are listed on the following pages as GE programs at JJC.

Does the institution (JJC) wish to have the educational program be, or remain, eligible for Title IV aid?

NO - If the answer is no, the program is NOT eligible for Title IV aid and, therefore is not a GE Program.

YES - If the answer is yes, continue to the next question.

Does the coursework lead to a degree, certificate, or other credential awarded by JJC?

NO - If the answer is no, the program is NOT eligible for Title IV aid and therefore is not a GE Program

YES - If the answer is yes, continue to the next question.

Is the institution (JJC) a for-profit (proprietary) institution?

YES - If the answer is yes, the program is a GE Program [See Note B below for two exceptions where the program is not a GE Program].

NO - If the answer is no, continue to the next question.

Is the credential that is awarded by the public or private non-profit institution a degree - associates, bachelor's, graduate, or professional (e.g., MD, DDS, DVM, JD)?

YES - If the answer is YES, the program is not a GE Program.

NO - If the answer is no, the program is a GE Program.

On-Time Graduation and Job Placement Rates

Colleges and universities are required to disclose "On-Time Graduation Rates," also referred to in the regulations as completion rates, for each group of students that graduates from the institution in the previous award year. The rate is calculated by dividing the number of on-time completers by the total number of graduates for the year by utilizing the formula below.

On-time graduation rate formula:

$$\frac{CGENormal}{CGEAnnual} * 100 = \%$$

CGENormal = # of students who complete the GE program within the normal timeframe.

CGEAnnual = Total # of students who completed the program during the most recently completed award year.
