Instructions for Table 2

1. These enrollment data will be used as criteria to determine space needs for construction purposes by the ICCB and IBHE.
2. Round to the nearest whole numbers.
3. Day FTE enrollments should be based on those courses scheduled to begin between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:50 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding non-credit instructional activities in public service.
4. Eligible Occupational FTE enrollments are derived from credit hours in ICCB approved occupational courses which include laboratory training. Internships, observations, practicums, etc., are not to be regarded as laboratory training. Credit hours in courses which qualify as eligible occupational enrollments must have a PCS code of 1.2 or 1.6 and must be approved with laboratory credit hours.
5. On-Campus students are those who have the majority of their instructional credit courses taught in on-campus facilities. Off-Campus students are those who have the majority of their instructional credit courses taught in other than on-campus facilities which are within the community college district. Students registered for equal numbers of credit hours at on- and off-campus facilities should be counted as on-campus students.
6. All Other Day FTE can be obtained by subtracting Eligible Occupational Day FTE from Total Day FTE. Any course approved by the ICCB for state funding, as well as courses not eligible for state funding because 50 percent or more of the support comes from federal or other state agencies, may be counted for space needs for construction formulas.
