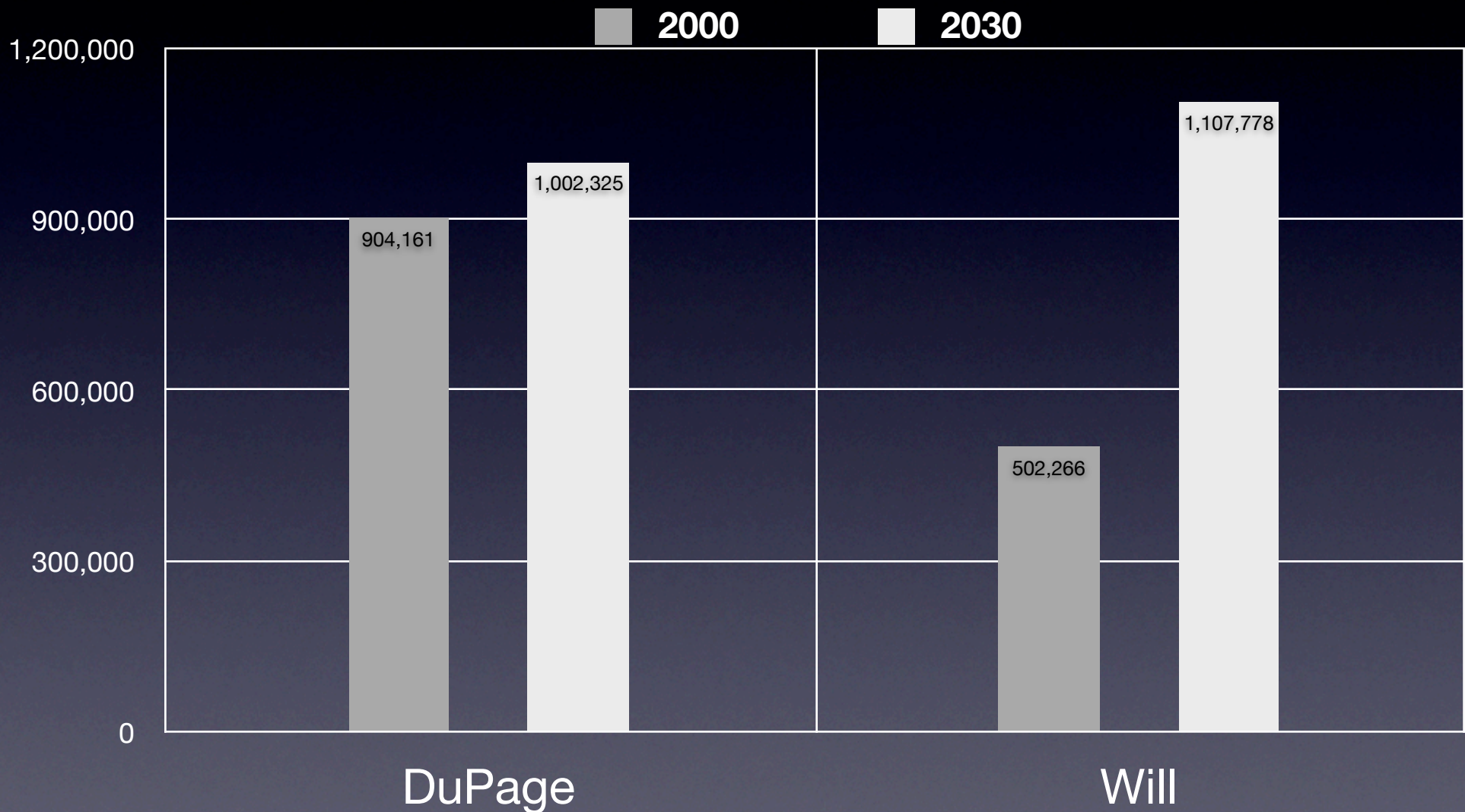

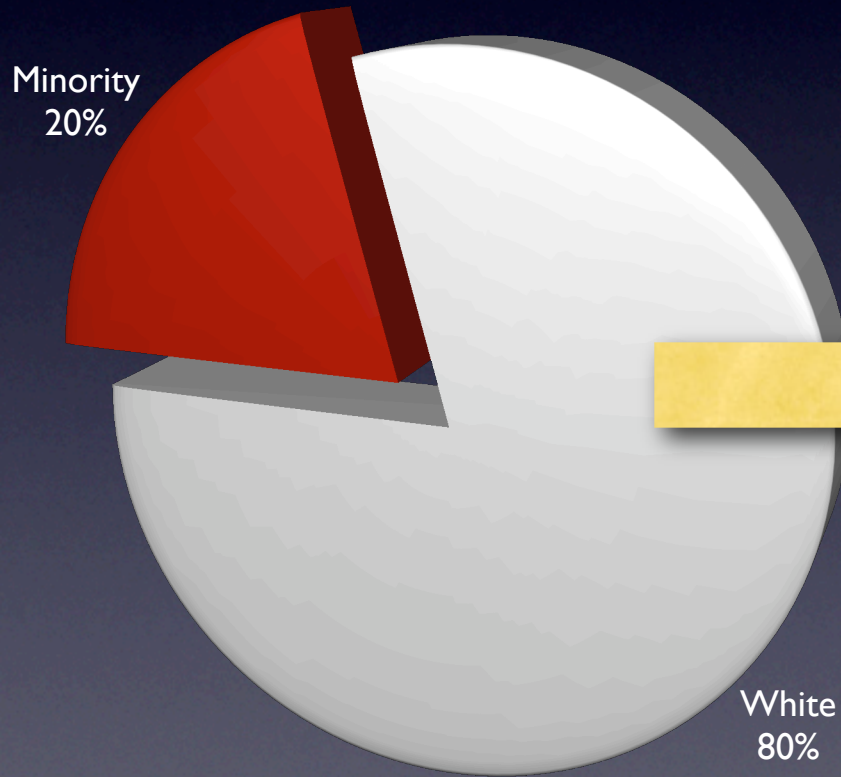
2000-2030 Population



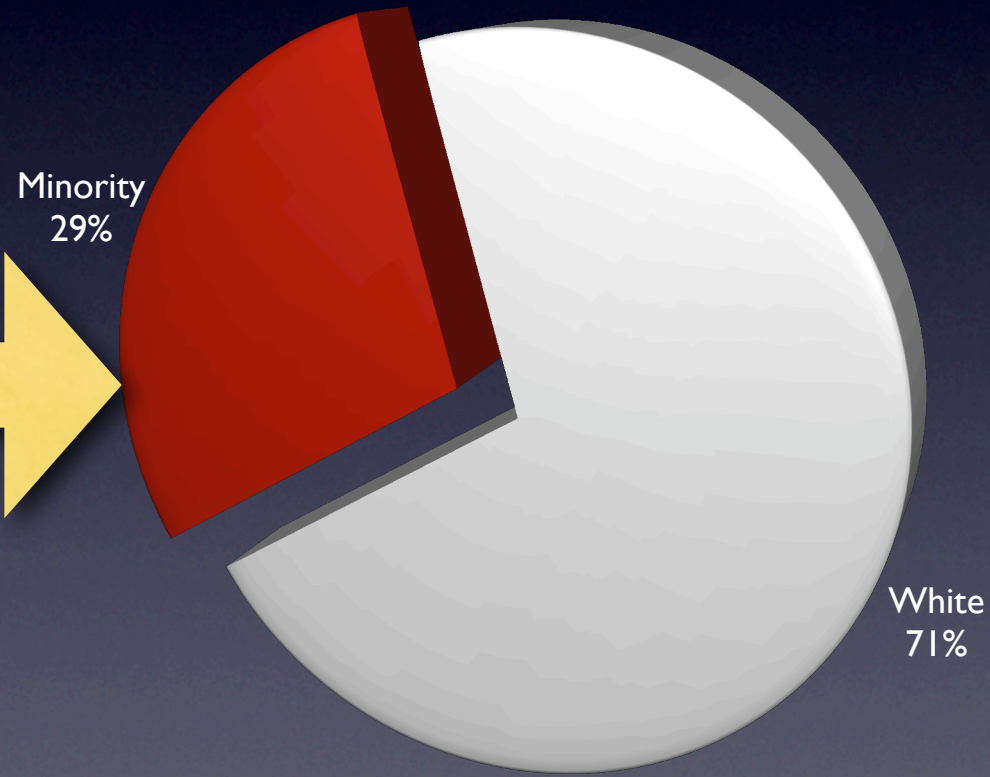

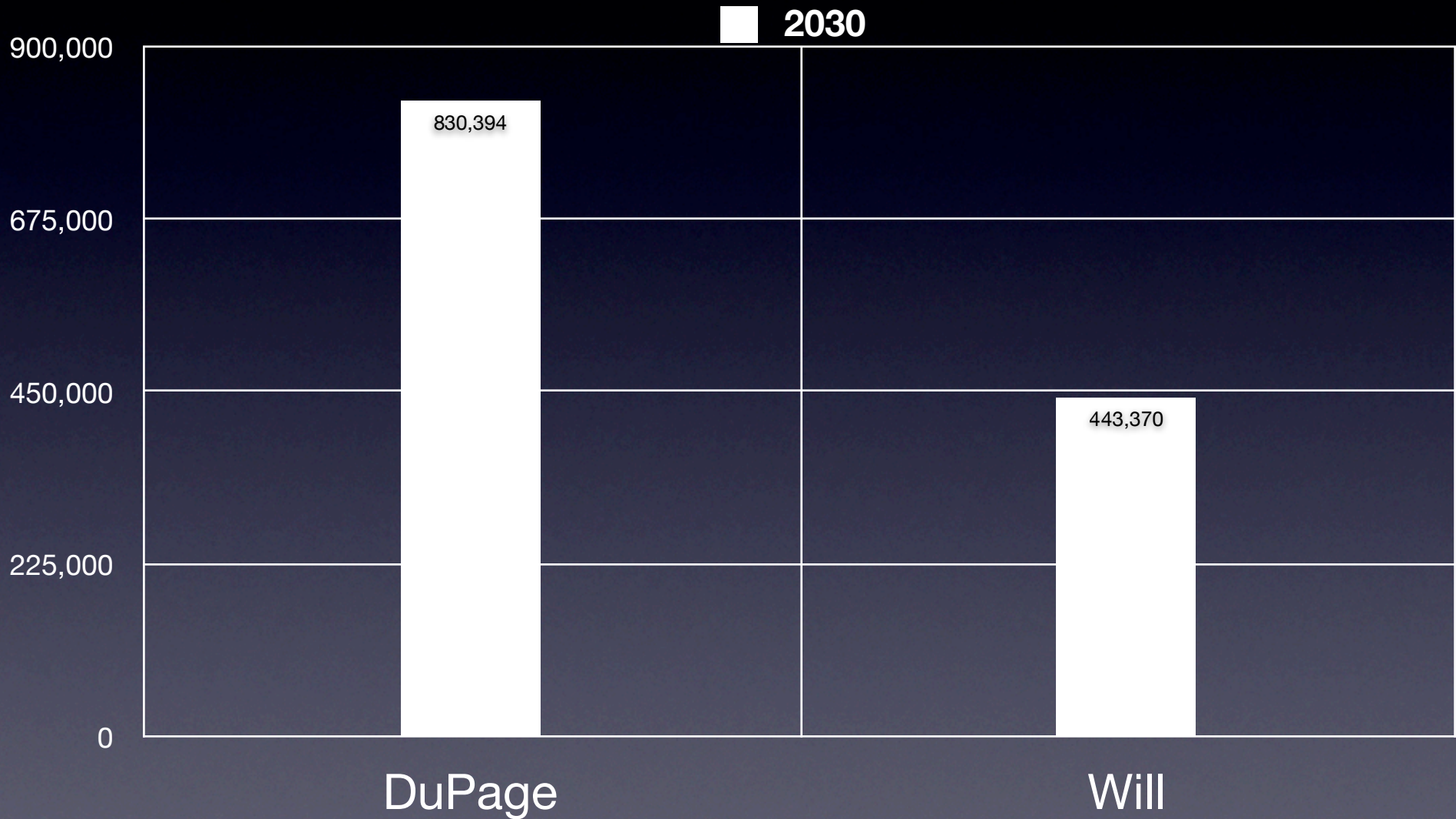

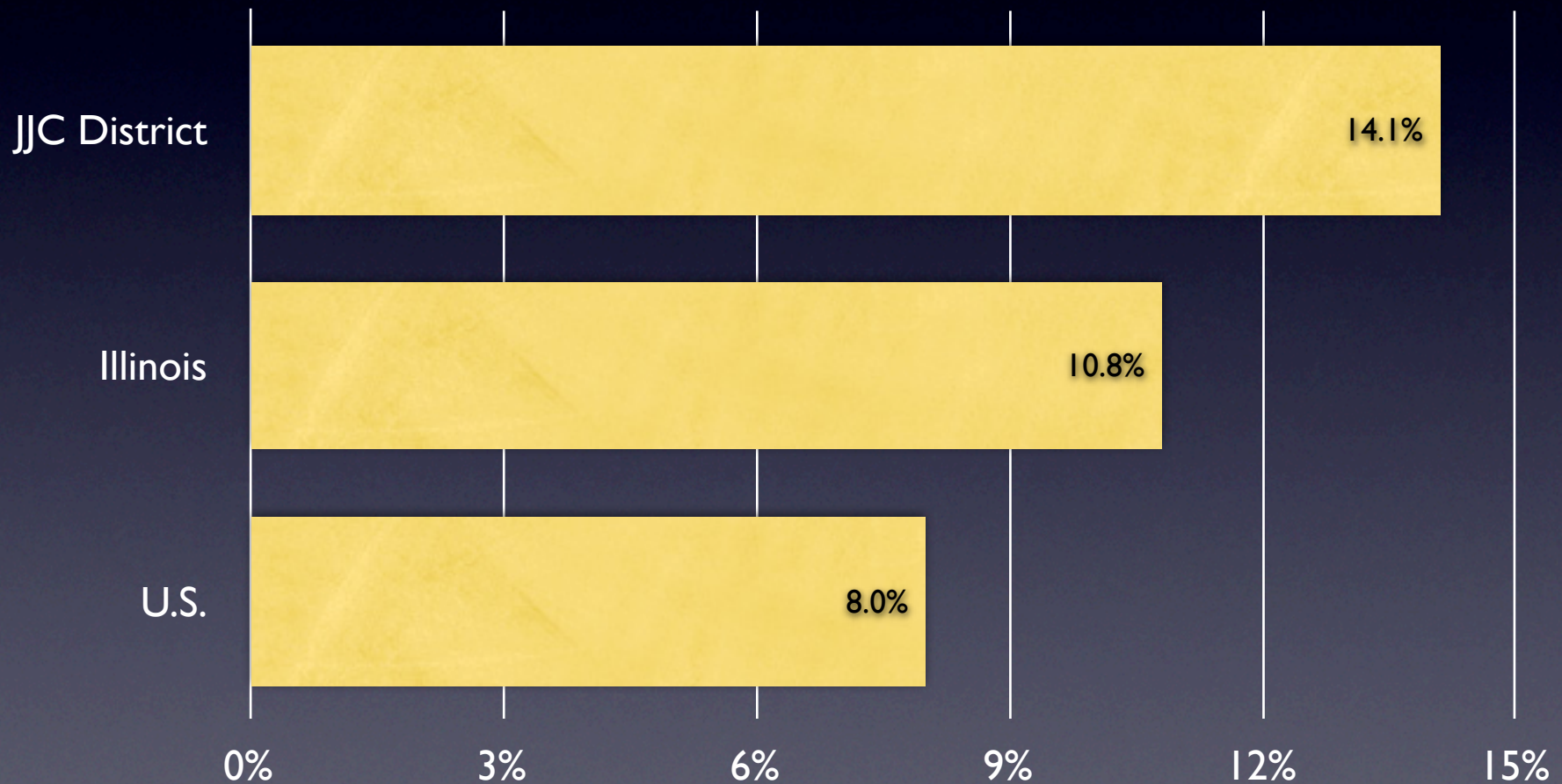


2030 Employees



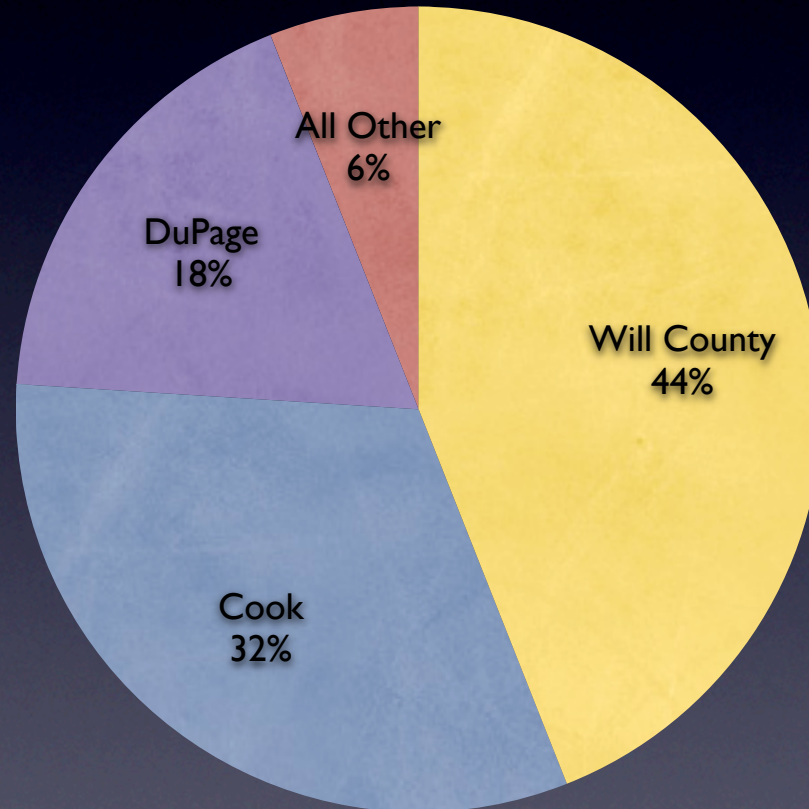

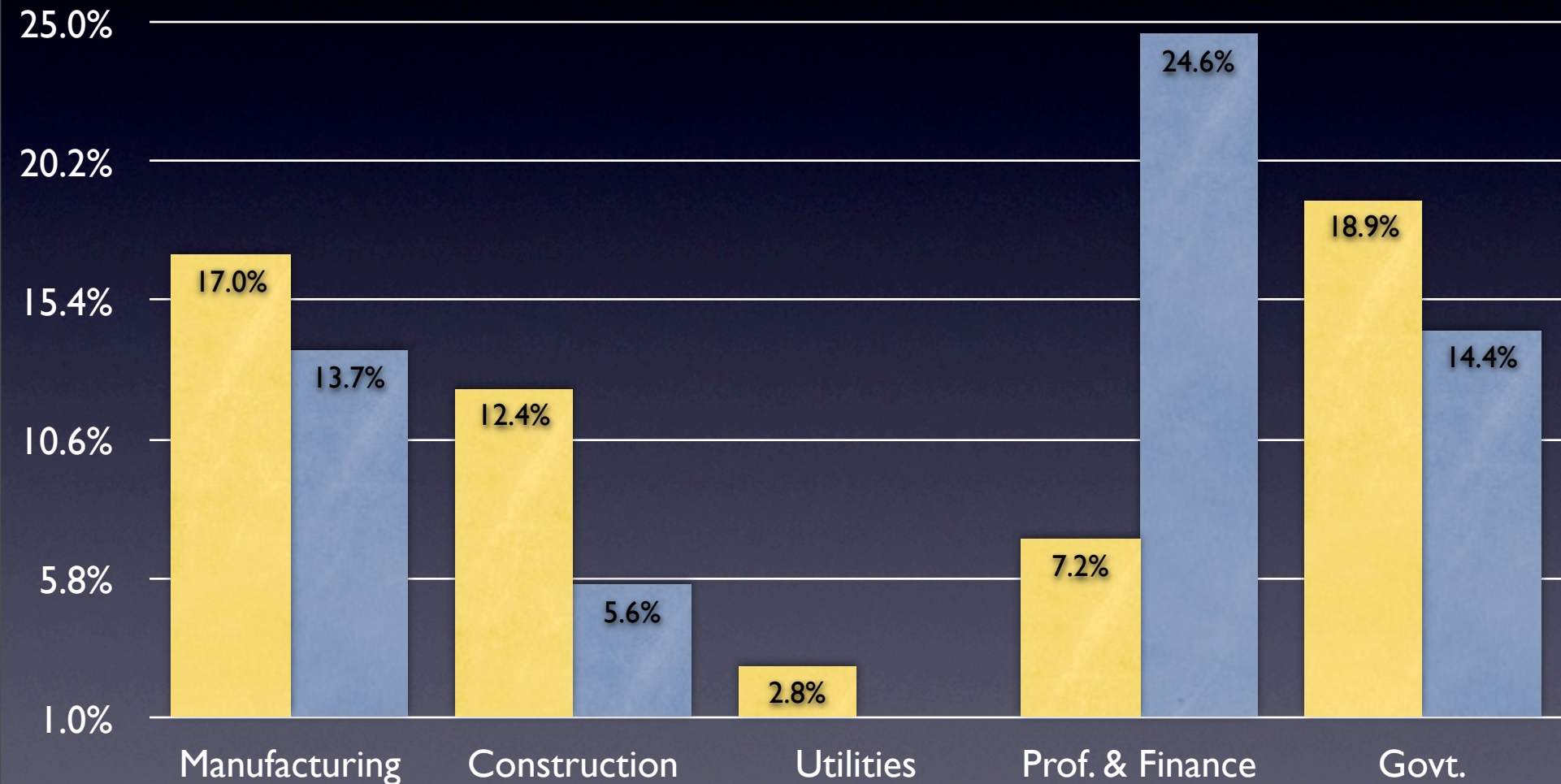
Where Will County Residents Work

Distribution of Wages

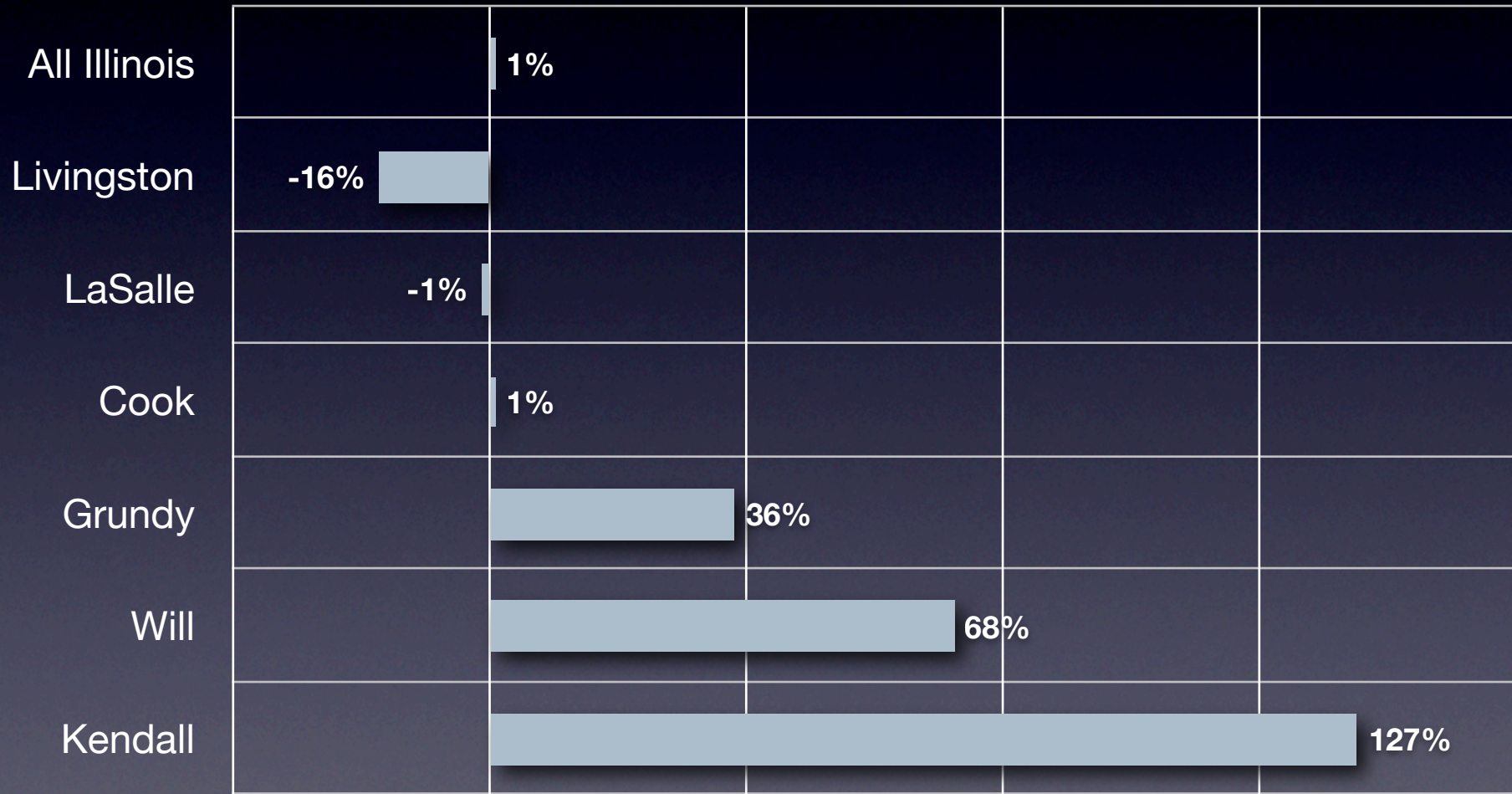
