Data Descriptions

This summary of retention rates is based on enrollments as of the 10th day of the semester. For instance, Fall to Spring retention rates are defined as the percent of students who were enrolled on the 10th day of the Fall semester and also enrolled on the 10th day of the Spring semester.

Data Considerations

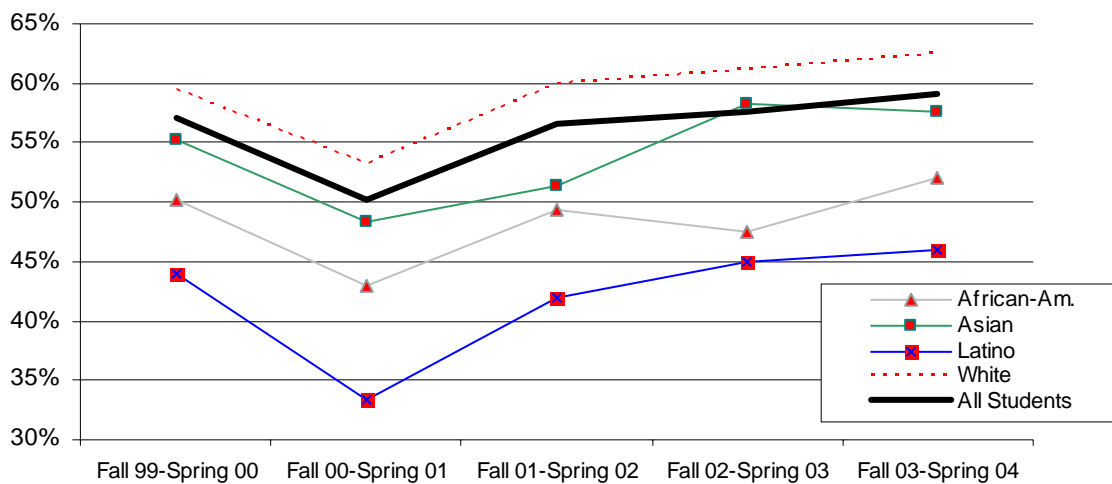
Retention rates should be examined with caution. If a student is not retained does not necessarily mean they did not complete their goal (e.g., upgrade computer skills through 2 classes). Further research into inputs (what student goals are when they enter college) and outputs (what happens to them after they leave) could shed more light.

Fall to Spring Retention Rates by Ethnicity at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004



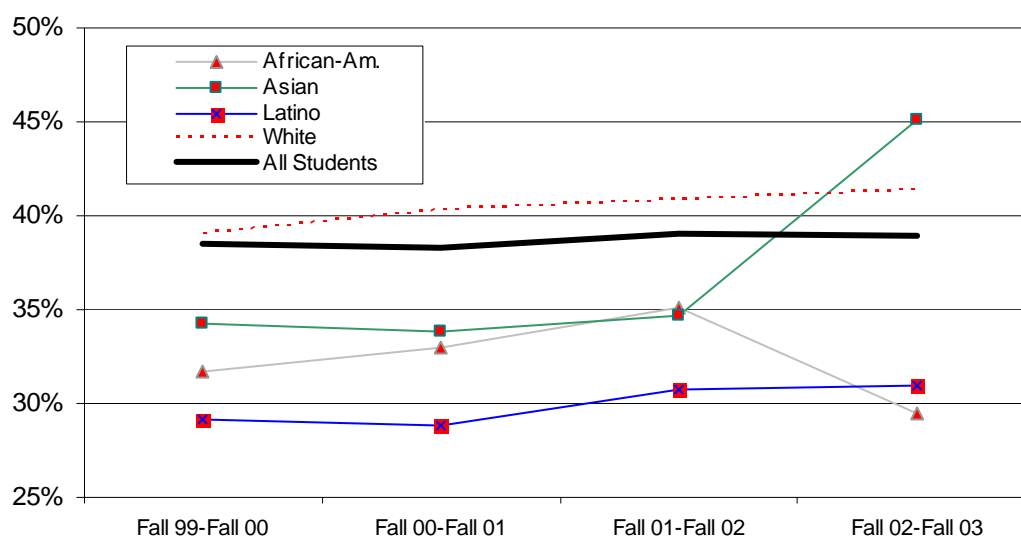

Fall to Fall Retention Rates by Ethnicity at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003



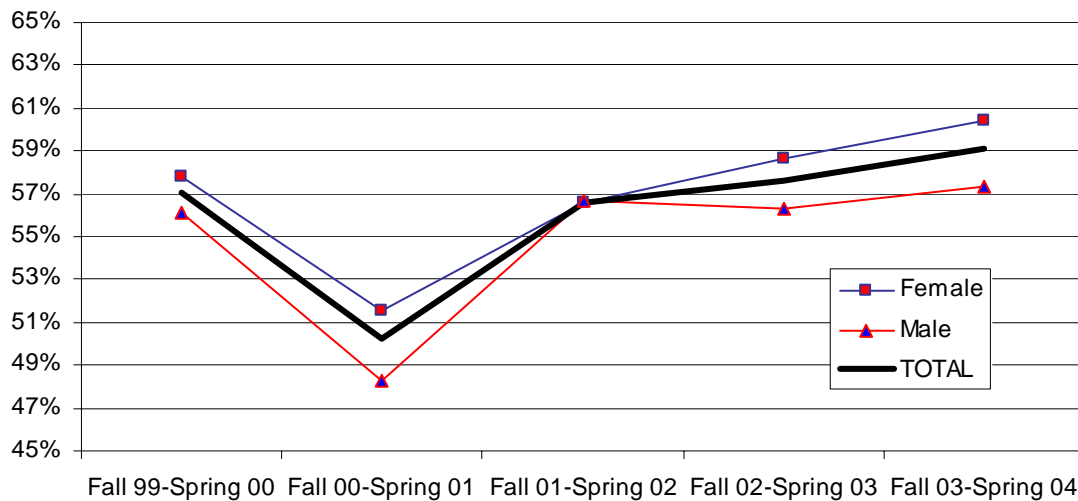

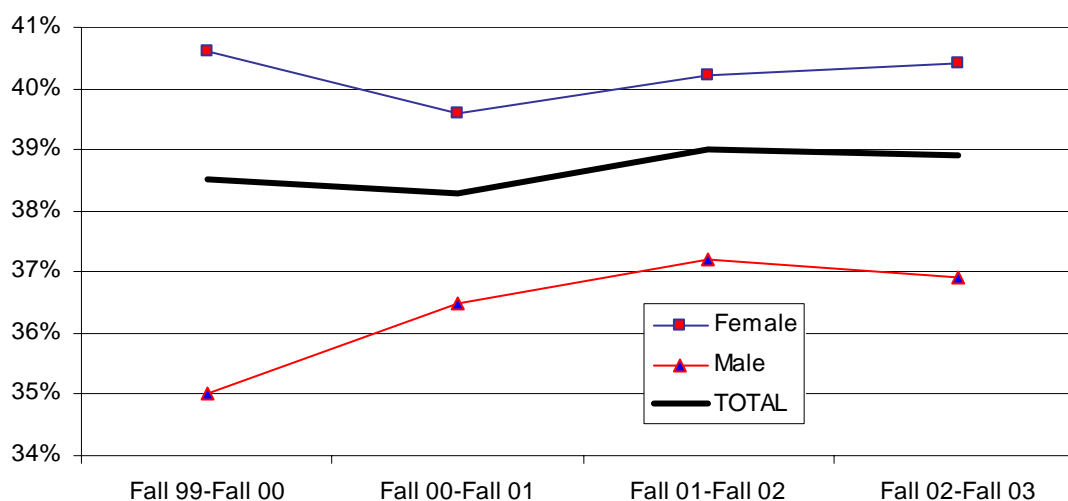

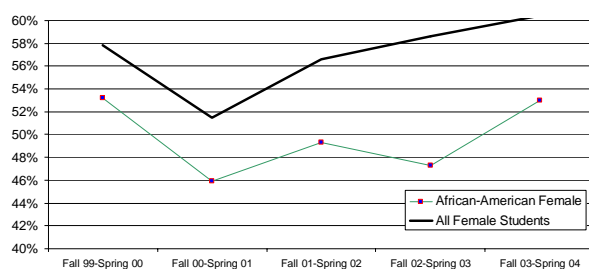

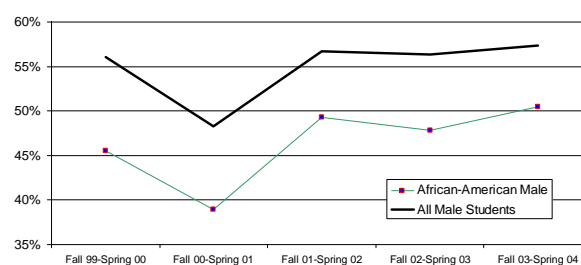

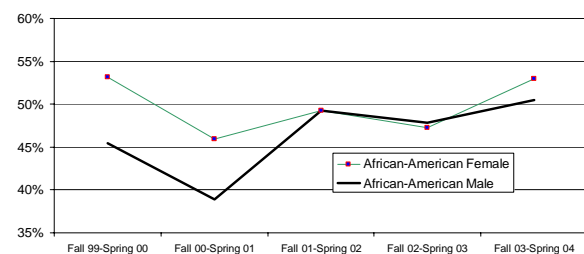
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for African-American Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004



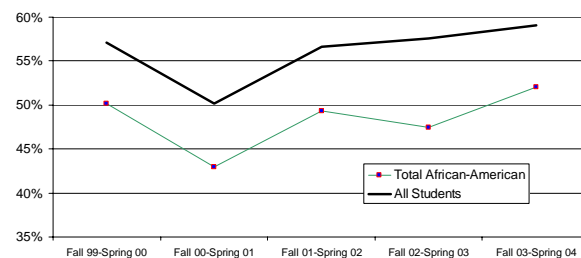
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for African-American Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004

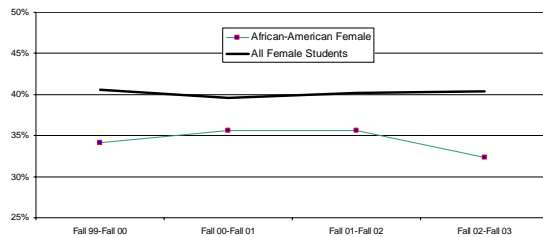

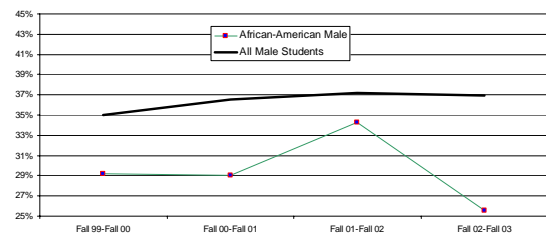

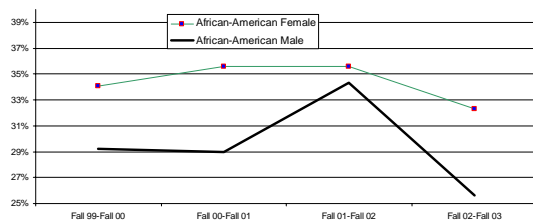
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for African-American Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003



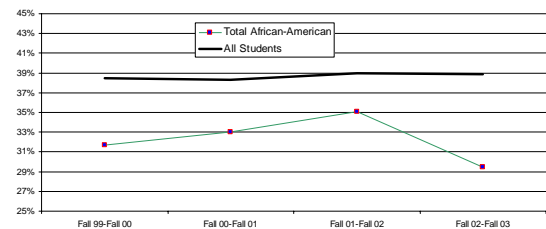
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for African-American Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003

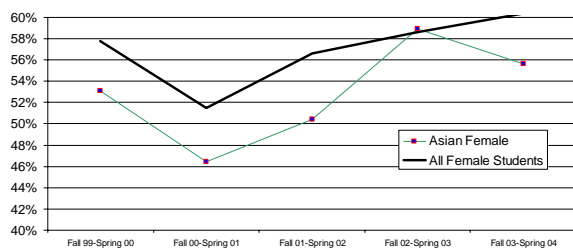

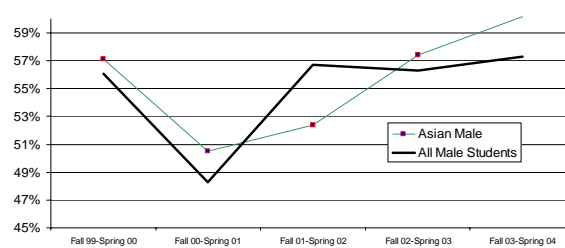

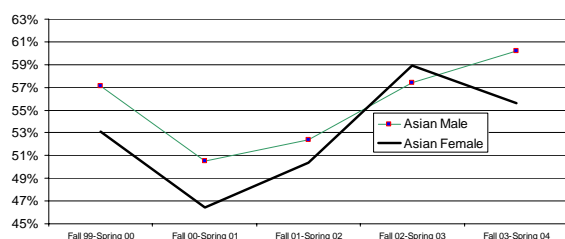
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for Asian Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004



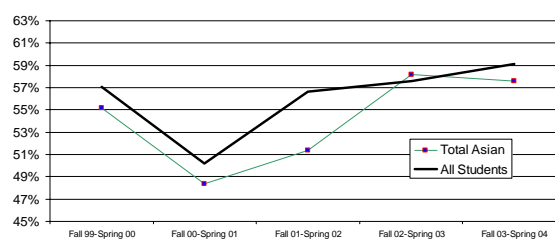
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for Asian Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004

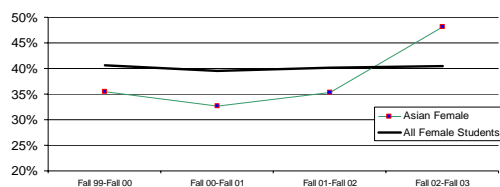

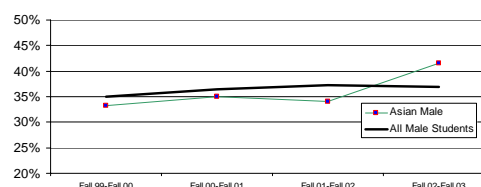

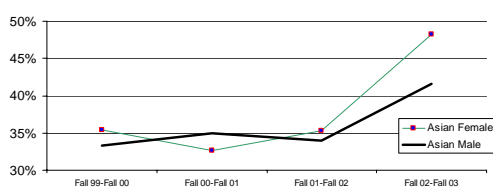
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for Asian Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003



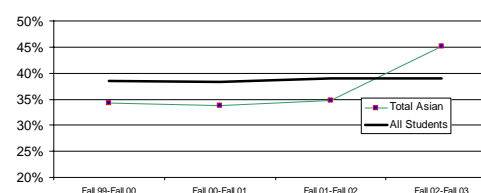
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for Asian Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003

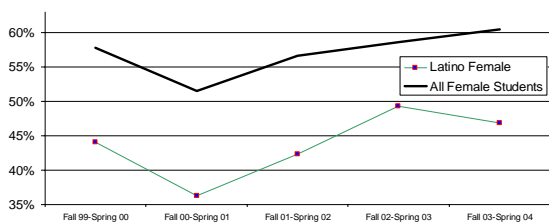

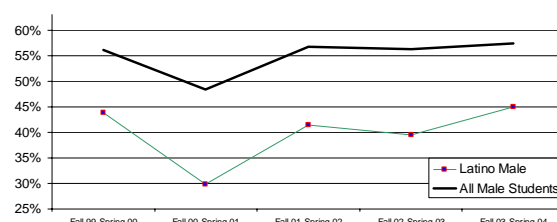

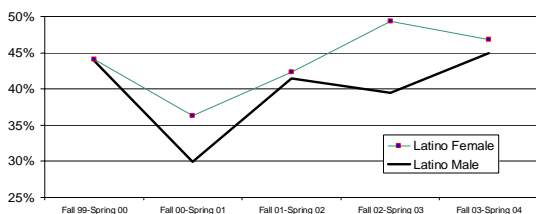
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for Latino Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004



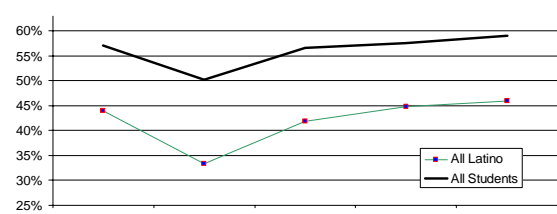
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for Latino Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004

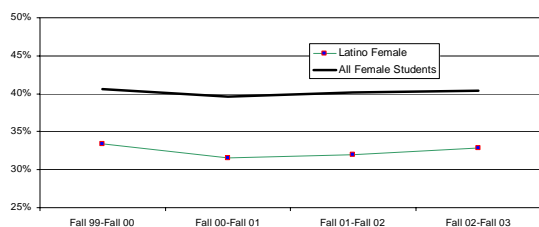

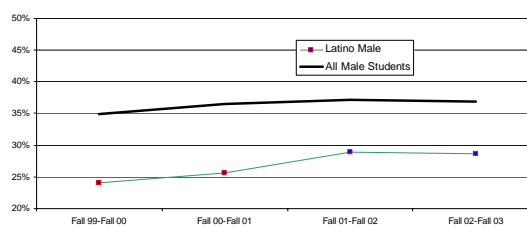

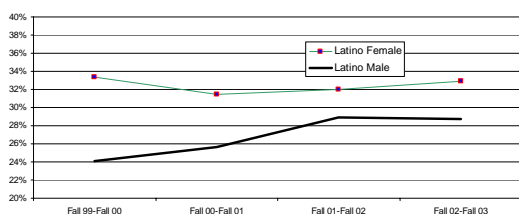
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for Latino Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003



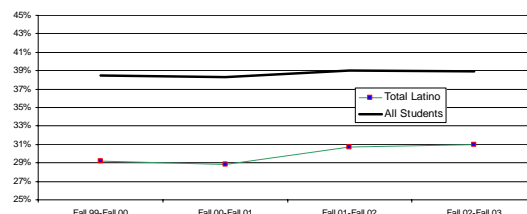
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for Latino Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003

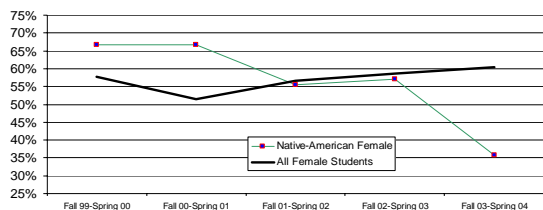

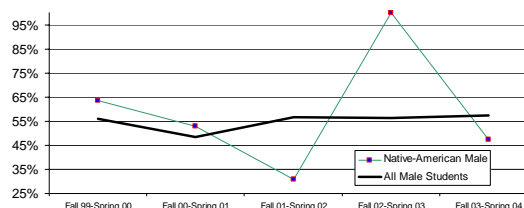

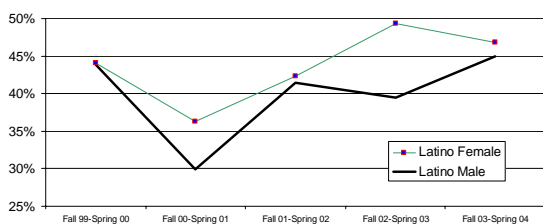
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for Native-American Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004



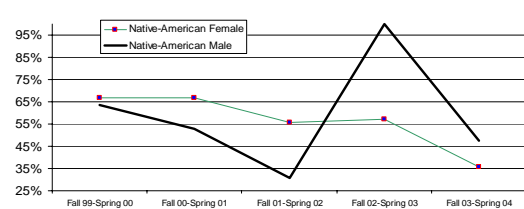
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for Native-American Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004

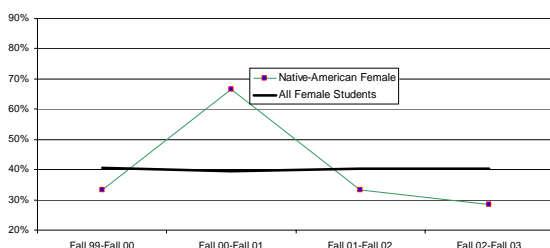

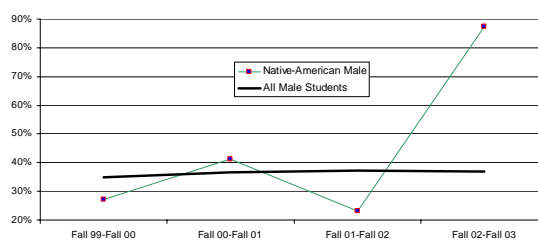

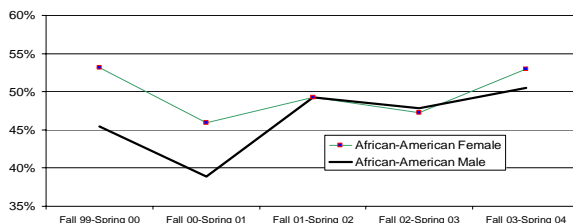
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for Native-American Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003



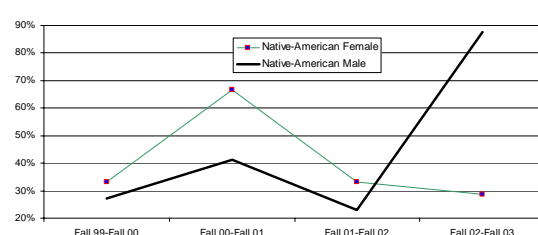
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for Native-American Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003

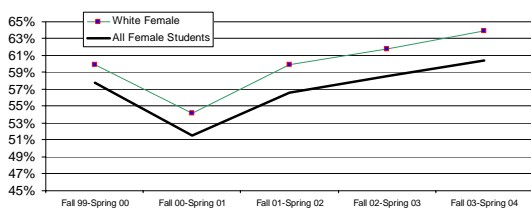

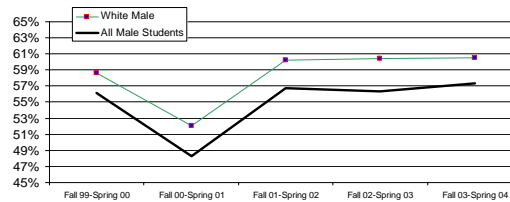

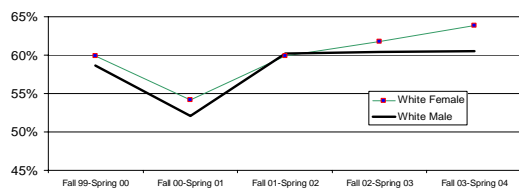
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for White Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004



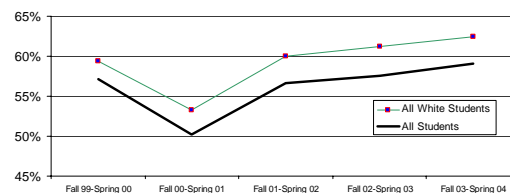
Fall to Spring Retention Rates for White Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2004

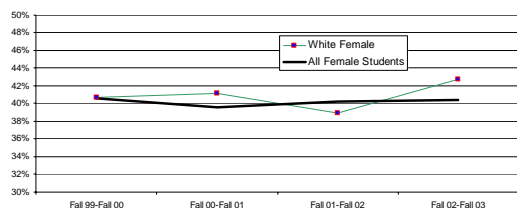

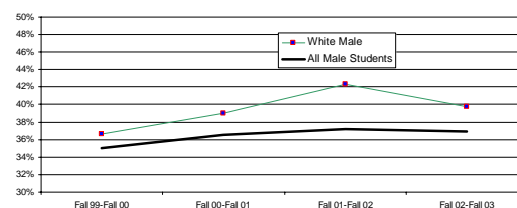

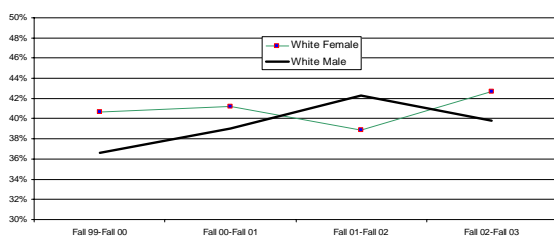
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for White Females and All Females at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003



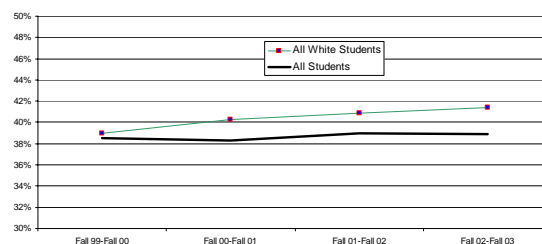
Fall to Fall Retention Rates for White Males and All Males at Joliet Junior College, 1999-2003
