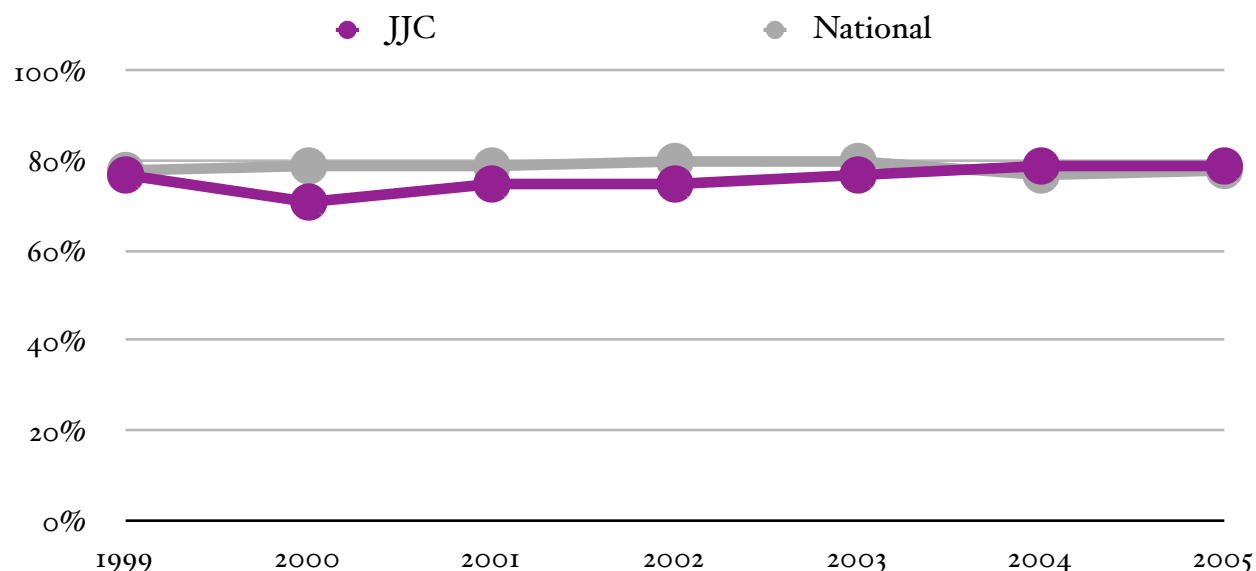


Respect for Racial Diversity: Faculty
