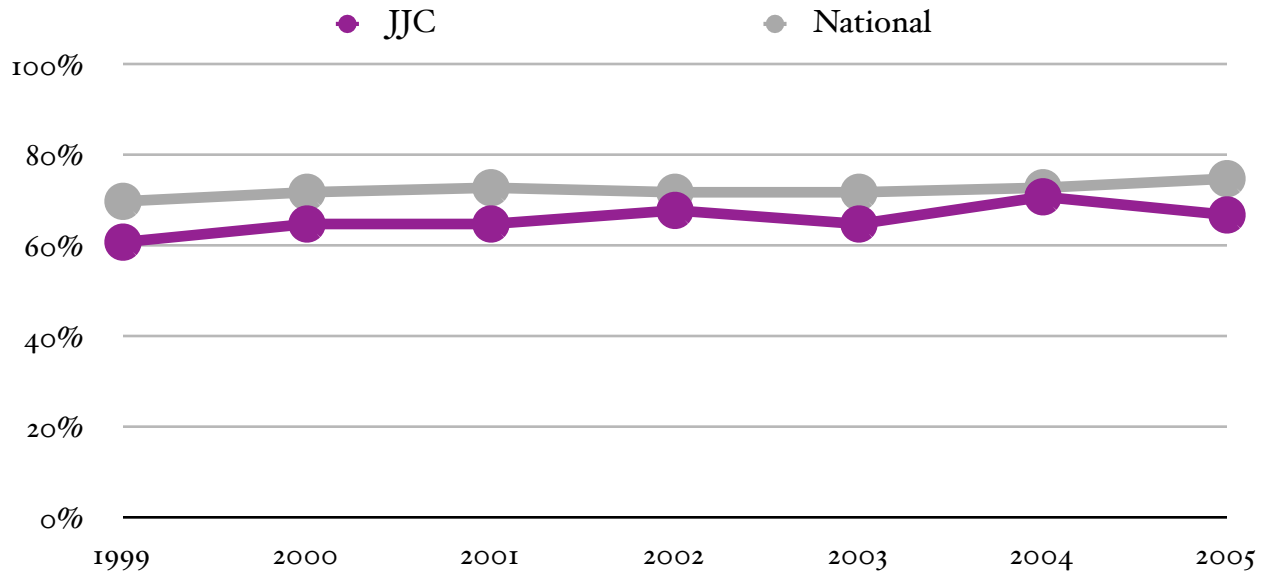


# Respect for Racial Diversity: Students
