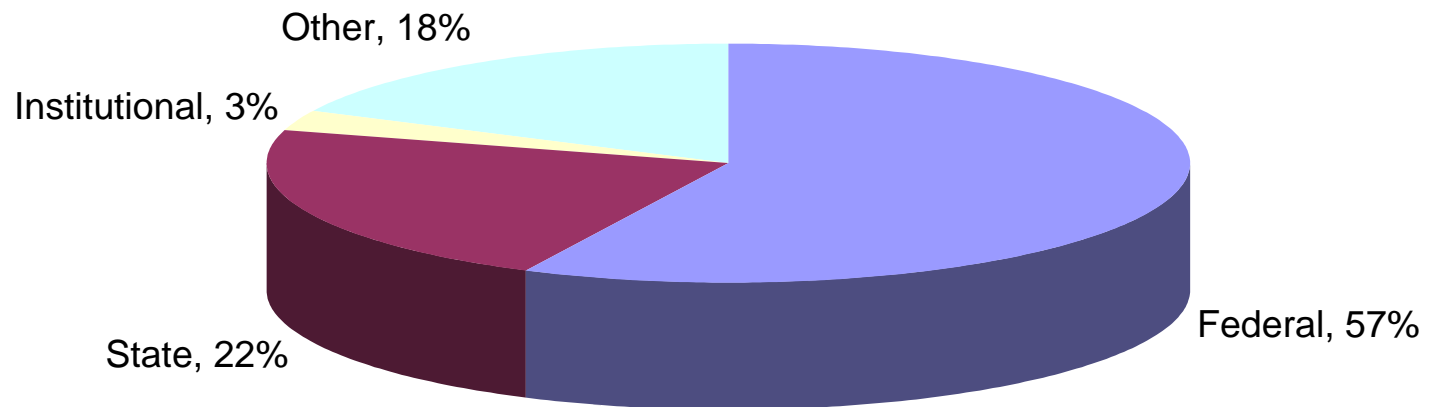

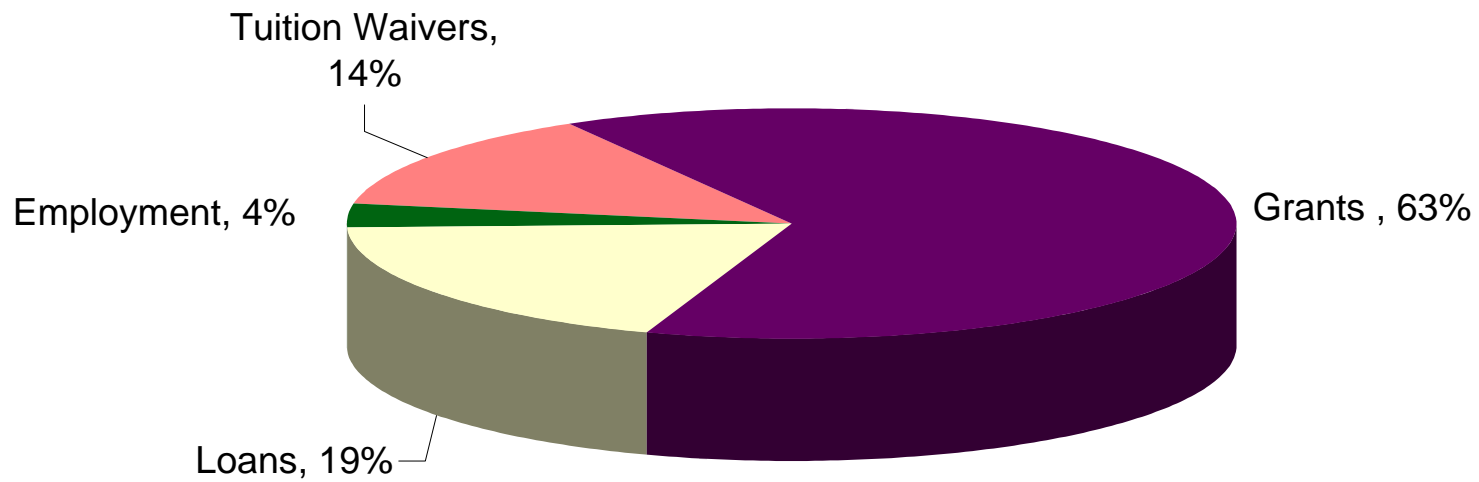

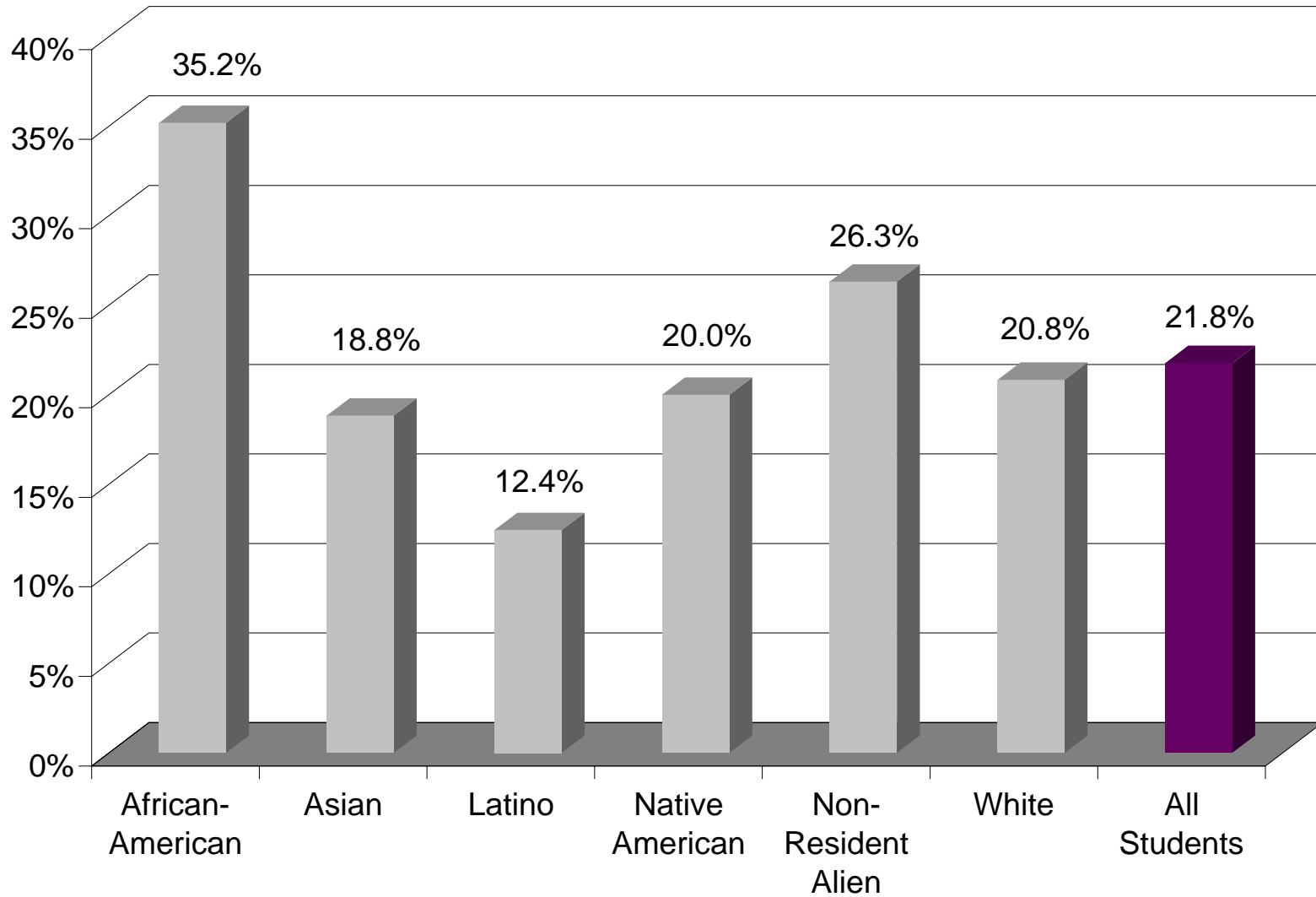
## Financial Aid Received by JJC Students by Source, FY 2004



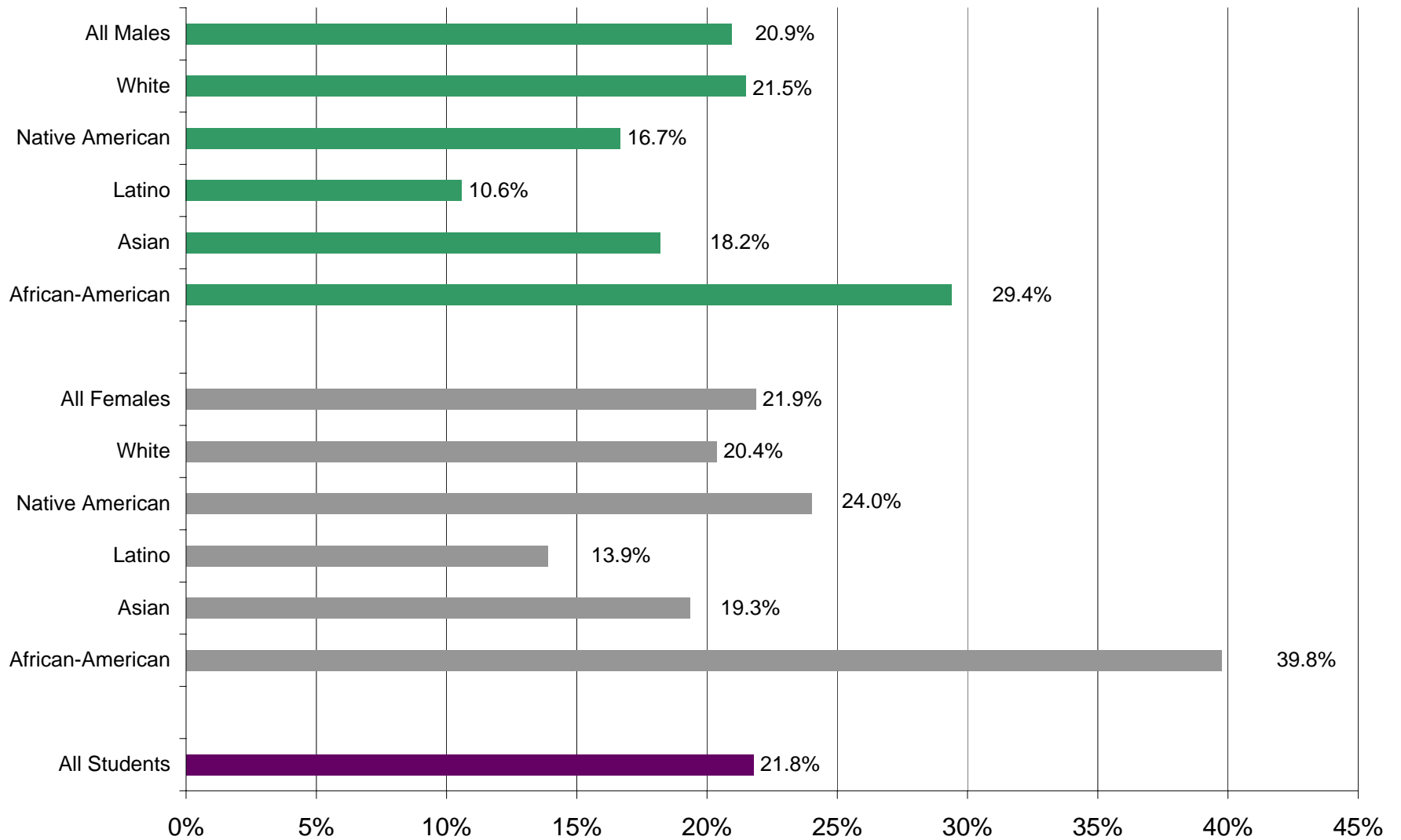
## Financial Aid Received by JJC Students by Type, FY 2004

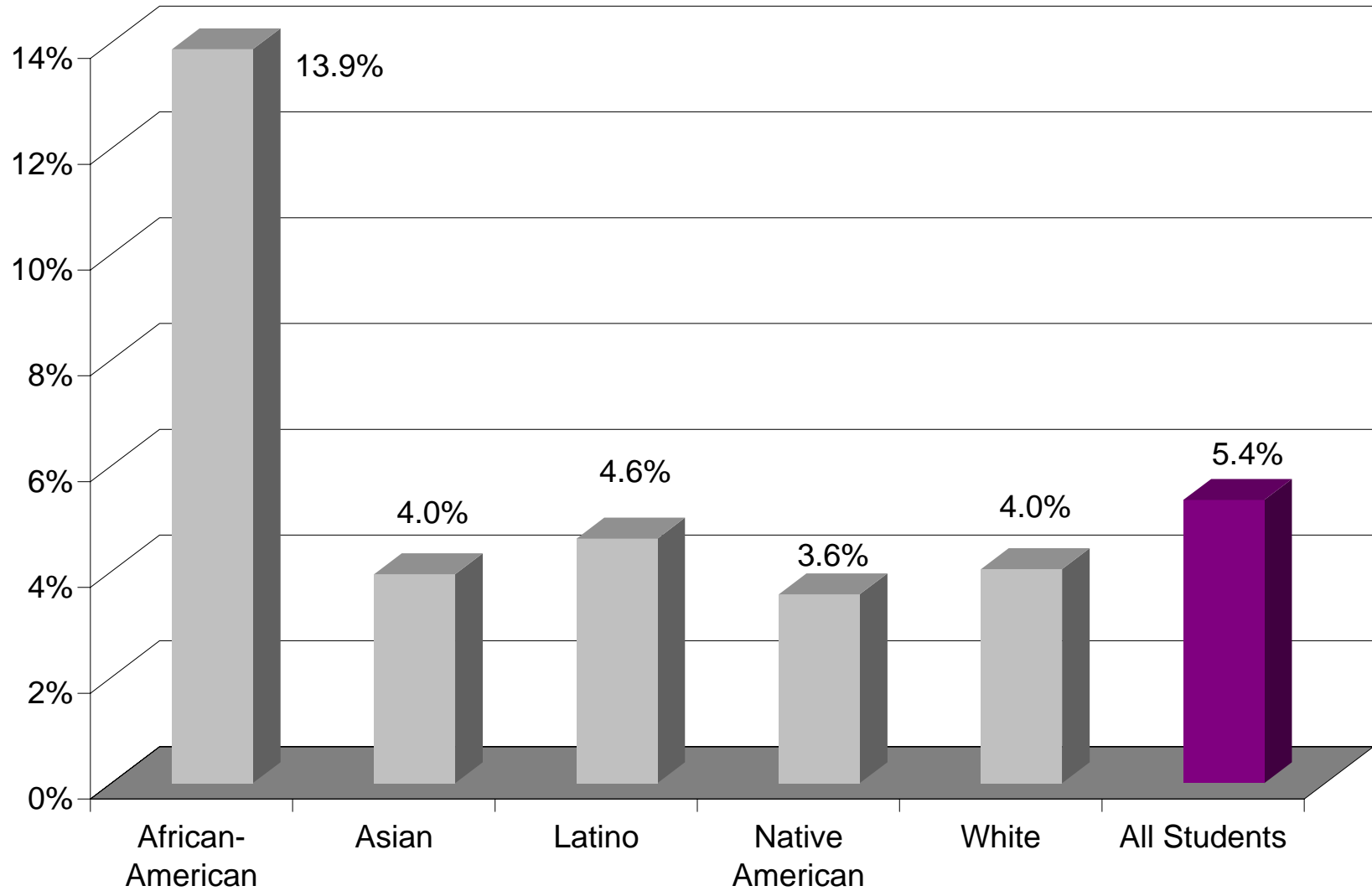

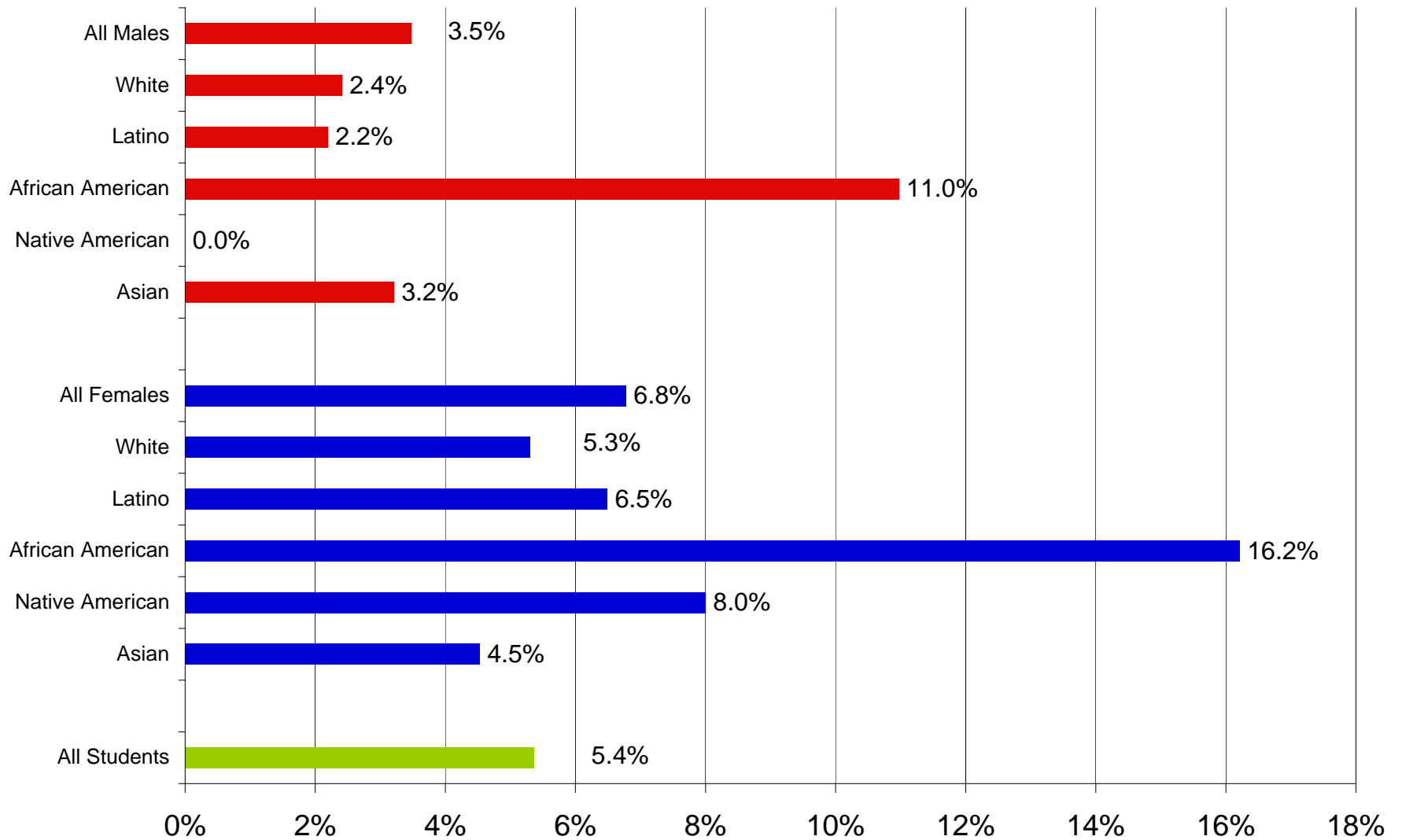
