General Instructions to All Bidders

The bids are to be dropped off at Room H1018/H1019 and they will be opened in the Highland Building, HI-108 which is in the office of Facilities services. Please note that H1018 is an interior office space that is located inside Room H1019.
- B.** All bidders are reminded that by submitting a bid, the bidder agrees to the content of the Bid Forms, Site Logistics Plan, and Safety Plan provided with the Bid Documents.
- C.** Please note the Bid Bond is to be drawn in favor of Joliet Junior College, Illinois Community College District No. 525 of Joliet, Illinois.
- D.** See attached sign-in sheet from the Pre-Bid meeting on September 9, 2010.
- E.** Incorporate into bid documents the responses to the following bidder inquiries into the scope of work:
 1. **Question:** I have been checking with the factory and the Automotive Lift Institute regarding alternate one and the requirements to change a 10K capacity lift to a 12K with just making a pressure change to the power unit and changing the superstructure; what I have been told is that the in doing so the lift will no longer be certified by ALI ETL Standards. Is that your understanding as well and if so does that mean the ALI / ETL certification is not a requirement for these vehicle hoists.
 - i. **Response:** Certifications are required. Upgrades performed by a factory trained technician using factory/manufacturers recommended parts should maintain the certifications.

All other terms and conditions of the Bid Documents remain the same.
