A MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Tuesday, July 27, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. CST in Room J0007 in Building J, at the Joliet Junior College, Illinois Community College District No. 525, 1215 Houbolt Road, Joliet, Illinois 60431. All prospective Bidders are required to attend this meeting to confirm the existing conditions.

This contract calls for the construction of a “public work,” within the meaning of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/.01 *et seq.* (“the Act”). The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to pay laborers, workers and mechanics performing services on public works projects no less than the “prevailing rate of wages” (hourly cash wages plus fringe benefits) in the county where the work is performed. For information regarding current prevailing wage rates, please refer to the Illinois Department of Labor’s website at: <http://www.state.il.us/agency/idol/rates/rates.HTM>. All contractors and subcontractors rendering services under this contract must comply with all requirements of the Act, *including but not limited to*, all wage, notice and record keeping duties.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the base bid is required from all Bidders. Guarantee Bonds in the form of a Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond in an amount equal to one hundred ten percent (110%) of the bid will be required from the awarded Bidder. The work will be done in accordance with the Contract Documents. “FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS INVITATION TO BID WILL RESULT IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE BIDDER”.

The Joliet Junior College, Illinois Community College District No. 525 reserves the right to reject any or all bids. This invitation is issued in the name of the Board of Trustees of Joliet Junior College, Illinois Community College District No. 525, Joliet, Illinois. All information submitted as part of this process shall be considered public information under the State Freedom of Information Act unless specifically disclosed on the applicable information by the Bidder.
