Response to questions pertaining to the Joliet Junior College Request for Proposal for the Online Academic Catalog Management Solution

1. First off, we do not fully qualify under 'Vendor Proposal Requirement 3. Customer References'. We do not have an off the shelf solution, rather we would propose building one for JCC using the Microsoft SharePoint portal product. We would reuse much of the Online Catalog we built for the University of Florida, but your solution would have additional features and integration. Further the solution we built for UF did not integrate with Curricunet. Would a proposal from B2B be considered?
The College requires integration with Curricunet.
2. What information needs to be pulled from Curricunet and Datatel Colleague? What types of inconsistencies do you want the e-catalog portal to detect?
The onus is on the vendor to share with the College their capabilities for various options and integration.
3. How strict is requirement #12? Can clicking a hyperlink on a Course Title take the user to another page in the e-catalog portal that displays course information?
This requirement is mandatory for the online catalog. The College is not directing the capabilities of the hyperlinks, we will review the available options presented by each vendor.
