This Addendum forms a part of the Bidding and Contract Documents and modifies the original bidding document as posted on the JJC website. Acknowledge receipt of this addendum in the space provided on the Bid Form. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY SUBJECT BIDDER TO DISQUALIFICATION.

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**THE BID DUE DATE HAS CHANGED TO: JANUARY 26, 2011 AT 2:00 PM.** The location remains the same: Joliet Junior College, Highland Conference Room, 1215 Houbolt Road, Joliet, IL 6031.

The following questions were submitted by the deadline:

- Has JJC chosen the placement for the cameras? Does this eliminate the need for a site survey from a camera perspective?*  
**The placement of the cameras have previously been determined. A typical installation was reviewed during the site walk-thru as part of the pre-bid meeting.**
- It was stated in the meeting that video surveillance services will consist of configuration work and not camera installation and mounting. Will JJC perform direction and initial lens focus as it mounts the cameras?*  
**Yes.**
- JJC has already selected and procured the cameras. Has JJC confirmed that the selected cameras are supported by the Cisco Video Surveillance solution?*  
**Yes.**
- Can you provide a list of the models of cameras and the number of each type that have been selected?*

5. *How many cameras are being managed by the existing VSOM solution?*  
**99.**
6. *How many video views are concurrently active through VSOM 21 and Virtual Matrix? Average and peak viewing estimates would be helpful. VSOM 21 and Virtual Matri.*  
**Approximately 15 to 24.**
7. *Has JJC already concluded a storage and capacity analysis for bandwidth and video archive yielding the set number of servers and disk drives that are the subject of this request?*  
**An estimate was derived using the formula (qty cam) x (1098KBS) @ 75% recording over a 21 day period.**
8. *Are all network structures supporting video surveillance including QoS and VLAN definitions in place today? If not then are they to be implemented by the JJC IT staff based on existing designs?*  
**Video surveillance is placed on dedicated VLAN'S at each location.**
9. *Page 3 of the bid indicates that the bidder may be required to offer samples upon request at no cost to the college. What type of samples fall under this requirement?*  
**No samples will be required.**
10. *Item 1 on page 12 mentions audio quality. Can you please elaborate on the configuration requirements for audio in this project?*  
**None required.**
11. *Item 6 on page 12 mentions remote support. Will JJC provide remote access during the course of the project? If so, what is the nature of that remote connection?*  
**Yes, Citrix.**
12. *Will you consider an extension of the deadline based upon the response to questions being issued at the end of the day on Friday, January 21?*  
**JJC will extend the due date, we will be able to extend the due date one day in order to meet deadlines for February Board of Trustees meeting.**
13. *The camera information indicates that 75% recording will be performed. Does this imply any of the following:*
  - Will recording only be done on motion? If so, how many such cameras will require individual field definitions and field motion testing to verify effectiveness?
  - Is this to mean 100% recording with motion triggered events?
  - Is the 75% figure intended to mean that recording will only be done during scheduled periods which equates to roughly 75% of the monitoring time?
  - Is record on motion or motion triggered events being used currently with the Cisco monitoring solution and the existing Axis cameras?**The cameras do not trigger on motion detection. The cameras record 24 hours per day seven days per week.**

14. *Was there a site survey performed and is it available?*  
**Any wireless site survey required to complete the scope of work shall be included in the base bid.**
15. *Can we review mounting locations?*  
**Yes, if an additional walk thru is needed contact Dave Johnson, Network Technician at (815)280-2697 to schedule an appointment.**
16. *Does each roof have penetration to IDF closets?*  
**Yes.**
17. *Do you know approx distance from AP placement to IDF?*  
**Cat6 cable is not part of this scope. Network cabling has been provided.**
18. *What type of smartnet is required for Mesh units and Bridges?*  
**8x5xNBD.**
19. *Does Joliet Junior College have enough AP controller licenses for additional units?*  
**Licenses will need to be included.**
20. *Do they have enough licenses for WCS for the 16 additional units?*  
**Licenses will need to be included in your base bid amount.**
21. *For the Cisco 1400 Bridge, what antenna does it require?*  
**JJC is open to recommendations by the vendor.**
