



Kishwaukee College/ICISP Carlow College Study Abroad Faculty Liaison Information and Application

Kishwaukee College is pleased to provide a new professional development opportunity for faculty members of ICISP member institutions. The faculty liaison position at Carlow College in Carlow, Ireland is designed to provide individuals from member institutions the opportunity to experience firsthand living, teaching and interacting with colleagues in an international setting.

FACULTY LIAISON RESPONSIBILITIES

Faculty assigned to this program will be expected to fulfill the following responsibilities:

- Teach a course for Carlow College.

OR

- Provide other mutually agreed upon service to Carlow College.

AND

- Oversee and provide leadership for the program and student service needs of students in Ireland.
- Assist Illinois students with the adjustment to living in a different culture.
- Assist with coordination of activities and field trips of the academic program with appropriate officers of Carlow College.
- Attend all sessions of The Irish Experience Class.
- Serve as chaperone on all field trips.
- Monitor students' independent travel.
- Perform administrative duties of the program as needed.
- Provide advisement to students as needed.
- Hold on-campus office hours.
- Through the appropriate officers of Carlow College, assist in solving problems which arise for Illinois personnel.
- Provide all appropriate information and communicate regularly with the program coordinator at Kishwaukee College.
- Attend the student/faculty orientation prior to assignment (usually held one Saturday in November and July).
- Assist with recruiting future participants.
- Assist with future faculty/student orientation sessions.
- Perform other duties as may be needed by ICISP.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT ONE OF THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES OF AN INSTRUCTOR IS TO ASSIST THE ILLINOIS STUDENTS ATTENDING CARLOW COLLEGE. AS SUCH, ICISP FACULTY MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO RESTRICT PERSONAL TRAVEL TO THOSE TIMES WHEN CLASSES ARE NOT IN SESSION. FACULTY MEMBERS SHOULD NOT COMMIT TO TEACHING ANY ON-LINE COURSES WHILE ASSIGNED TO CARLOW COLLEGE.

Instructors assigned to teach at Carlow College will be required to sign an agreement verifying that the above responsibilities are understood and agreed upon.

Compensation for ICISP Instructors:

Salary – Paid by home college

Housing – Carlow College provides housing free of charge to individual faculty members. Because this is a newly created program, specific details are not available at this time regarding the housing. Faculty are advised to verify housing status at the selection interview.

Airfare and transportation to Carlow College – Paid by ICISP up to \$1000

Extra Allowance – Optional by home college

 - how they expect the experience to impact their professional development; and
 - previous international experience, if any.
- A curriculum vitae limited to two pages

The deadline for receipt of all materials is MONDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2008. Incomplete/late applications will not be considered. Those applicants selected for an interview will be notified by telephone. In the event of a very large pool, there will be a two-step interview process, with the first round of interviews to be conducted by telephone. Finalists will be interviewed in person at Parkland College. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 2008. *Applicants are requested to please hold that date until they learn whether or not they will be interviewed.*
