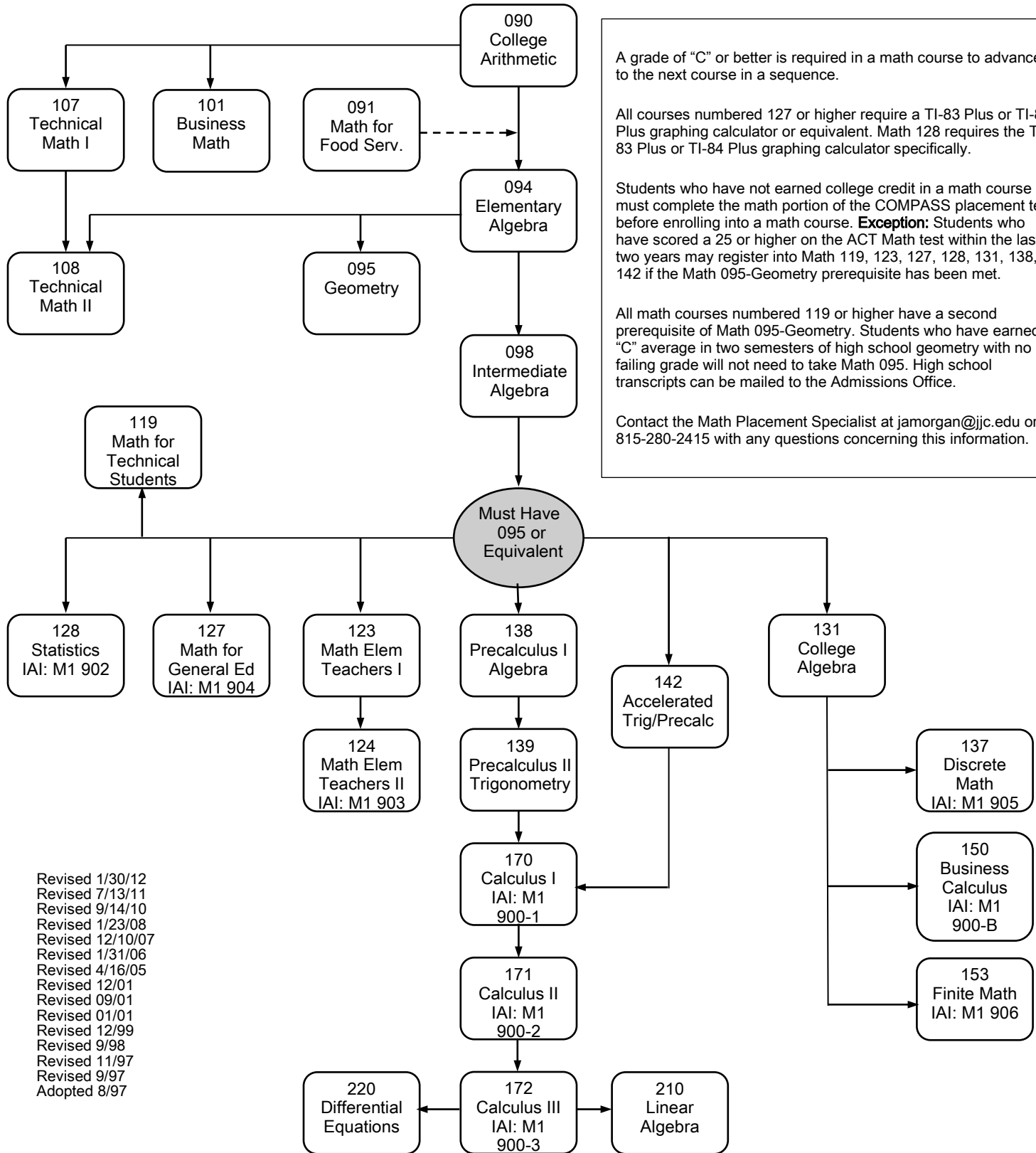


Joliet Junior College Sequence of Mathematics Courses



A grade of "C" or better is required in a math course to advance to the next course in a sequence.

All courses numbered 127 or higher require a TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus graphing calculator or equivalent. Math 128 requires the TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus graphing calculator specifically.

Students who have not earned college credit in a math course must complete the math portion of the COMPASS placement test before enrolling into a math course. **Exception:** Students who have scored a 25 or higher on the ACT Math test within the last two years may register into Math 119, 123, 127, 128, 131, 138, or 142 if the Math 095-Geometry prerequisite has been met.

All math courses numbered 119 or higher have a second prerequisite of Math 095-Geometry. Students who have earned a "C" average in two semesters of high school geometry with no failing grade will not need to take Math 095. High school transcripts can be mailed to the Admissions Office.
