Step 1:

Submit your application for admissions at www.jjc.edu/admissions

Step 2:

Look up your JJC ID number, username, and password at www.jjc.edu/info/password-help

Step 3:

Send a copy of your high school transcripts or GED to the Admissions Office. If the transcript is not sent prior to registration, it may delay registration for a college level math course.

Step 4:

Complete the ACT COMPASS Placement Test OR submit ACT scores to the Admissions Office (if your scores do not meet the criteria for placement you must take the ACT COMPASS Placement test).

- ACT Math score must be 25 or higher for placement purposes
- ACT English score must be 23 or higher for placement purposes

Step 5:

Apply for financial aid and scholarships (www.jjc.edu/info/financialaid) (not required in order to complete the admissions/NSO process)

Step 6: (recommended but not required for Part-time students)

Step 7:

Attend your New Student Orientation (NSO).

At the NSO you will:

- Learn about JJC
- Meet with a Counselor to discuss course recommendations
- Learn how to use e-resources and register for classes

Be sure to check your reservation ticket for items you need to bring with you to your NSO. Your ticket confirms your NSO date, time and location. If you were unable to print the ticket please check your JJC email for a electronic copy .
