

# VuFIND CATALOG

## (The new catalog interface for JJC Library)

VuFind is the alternative interface for CARLI libraries. Previously, the JJC Library used the “classic” interface. VuFind is very similar to the classic interface, except it allows for patrons to access information at multiple points without doing multiple searches (ex: searching a title will also bring up the subject headings and topic links to other materials related to the title searched.)

The front page looks like this:

Try the new VuFind discovery interface for your I-Share library catalog. If you are new to VuFind you will want to [create a new account](#)

Patrons have the ability to search for materials using the same access points (title, keyword, subject, author, ISBN) from a single search box (see above).

With the new interface, patrons are able to manage their library transactions (see circled items). This account will allow them to save a search session in the catalog, tag items, see which items they currently have checked out, order items from libraries within Illinois and renew materials checked out from JJC Library and other libraries in Illinois.

There is also an advanced search which allows the patron to search for items from multiple access points: Title, keyword, author, format (book, magazine, CD, DVD, etc), and language.



Notice the right-hand side links. Here patrons are able to further their query by finding additional topic-related materials through; authors, topics, subject areas, language and genres.

The retrieval information is accessed after a specific item is selected. If the patron wishes, the item information (title, author, location, availability) can be texted to them, by selecting the “Text me the call number” hyperlink within each item’s holding:
