## The Classes That We Offer

### **FS - 010 Basic Sanitation Procedures**

Students will develop a practical understanding of the basic sanitation procedures needed to secure and maintain employment in the food service industry.

### **CA-011 Basic Storeroom/Customer Service**

Students gain practical experience in basic customer service and the basic procedures needed to maintain storage facilities food service facility.

### **CA-012 Basic Cooking of Prepared Food**

Students gain practical experience in the preparation of prepared hot foods and the importance of teamwork and sanitation

### **CA-013 Basic Grill & Fast Food Preparation**

Students learn to work in the griddle station of a food service establishment preparing breakfast and luncheon items.

### **CA-014 Cold Food Preparations**

Students develop a practical experience in the preparation of salads and sandwiches while following sanitation procedures.

In cooperation with local high schools and other support agencies, this program is designed to teach entry level employability skills and enhance independent living for this special needs population in the communities we serve.

Students enrolled in Foodservice Vocational Skills courses gain experience through the handling of tools and equipment needed for each specific area of foodservice as well as overall sanitation and safety practices. Student progress and success is evaluated through use of a skill mastery checklist as well as hands on demonstration of acquired skills and knowledge.
