Applying for scholarships can be a new and difficult process, so JJC's Writing and Reading Center (WRC) wants to help you enhance the writing portion of this process. The tutors at the WRC are here to assist you through each step of the way. During the Spring 2012 semester, the center, in collaboration with the Foundation, will be offering a specialized workshop on how to write a scholarship essay. The workshop will provide an overview that contains tips, advice, and assistance in beginning and revising your application essay.

In addition to the scholarship essay workshop, WRC tutors are available to help with all scholarship applications. Tutors will help students brainstorm for ideas, develop their answers to application questions, and add details to their essays. Writing and Reading Center tutors are also available to help students draft thank you letters to the scholarship donors after receiving an award.
