



Approvals for getting into courses with general education prerequisites

Reverse transfer students should be encouraged to follow the formal process for getting transcripts from previous institutions evaluated through the Academic Credentials/Records Office prior to registering for courses at JJC. If students bring in transcripts from their previous college(s) and wish to register for JJC courses that have English, math, or other general education/ IAI approved courses as prerequisites, they can get a signature approving the prerequisite course(s) according to the information in the chart below. For questions about developmental English equivalents, contact the Department.

Counselors do not attempt to verify prerequisites for specific skill classes in the career and technical areas, music, art, or science; students are referred to the program coordinators and advisors to work out appropriate course enrollment.

This agreement has been in place for a number of years and will continue until the Counseling Department is notified by an Academic Department that they wish to make a change in the approval process.
