- ▶ **4-time Women’s World Chess Champion and the only World Champion (male or female) to win the Triple-Crown in Chess** (Rapid, Blitz and Standard Time Control World Championships)
- ▶ **3-time Olympic Champion and 6 overall Medals** (3 Gold, 2 Silver, and 1 Bronze)
- ▶ **3-time winner of the most prestigious “Chess Oscar”** (Latest in March '04)
- ▶ **First woman ever to win the celebrated Grandmaster of the Year Award** (August '03)
- ▶ **First woman ever to win the US Open Blitz Chess Championship** (August '03)
