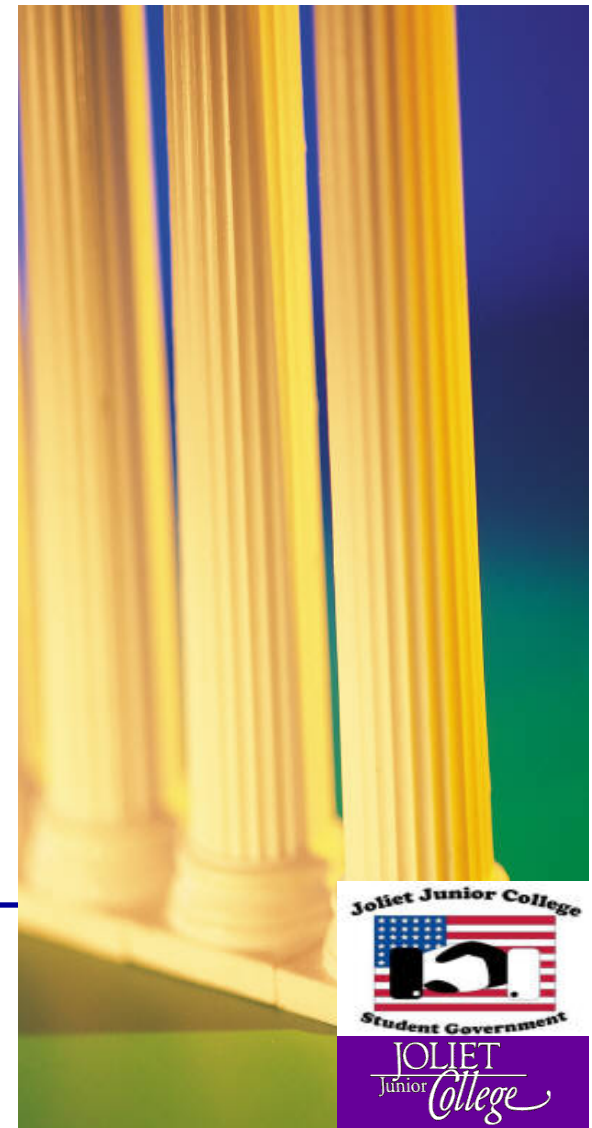

## What is Student Government?

The Joliet Junior College Student Government is comprised of representatives of the general student body. Our purpose is to gather and represent the opinions, rights and interests of the students of Joliet Junior College. Additionally, the members of Student Government serve as a vehicle of expression for students through sound communication with faculty, staff, administration and the Board of Trustees.



There are several positions a student can hold on the Student Government: *President, Vice-President, Diversity Officer, Promotions/ Programming Rep., Treasurer, Secretary, North Campus Rep., City Center Rep., Centennial Commons Rep., and Student Body Representative at-large.*

## How does Student Government represent your interests?

Members of Student Government have the option of participating on several standing committees and task forces where student opinion is needed.

**Academic Standards Committee:** The primary goal of the ASC is to maintain quality by promoting high standards of teaching and learning, acquiring equipment and technology to meet needs in education, and promoting information that examine educational problems and trends.

**Technology Planning Committee:** Joliet Junior College implemented a technology fee for students and this committee was granted a budget. The TPC is responsible for reviewing the purchase requests for all information technology equipment. The TPC budget also includes funds for training, salaries and funds for exploring new technology at JJC.

**Academic Quality Improvement Plan:** AQIP Committee members work with staff and faculty to plan and achieve institutional goals according to JJC’s North Central Accreditation process.

## Goals

The following five goals were established by Student Government to be addressed for the 2005-2006 Academic year. Various sub-committees within SG have been formed to address these areas :

- Recruitment and restructuring of Student Government to create more accessibility for all JJC student voices
- Explore the rising cost of textbooks for college students
- Identify areas where Student Government can become more involved with the outside community
- Explore whether tutoring options need to increase for JJC students
- Assess meal options for JJC students including accessibility, cost and selections
