ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Student Leadership Scholarship is an award designed to recognize the efforts of students who contribute their time in leadership roles of clubs **OR** participate in the Student Leadership Institute sponsored by the Office of Student Activities.

The student must be an active member of an officially-chartered club **OR** have attended a minimum of 2 Leadership Institute sessions in the semester (including the Leadership moments provided at the Collegiate Club Council meetings).

Cash awards in the amount of \$250 each will be awarded at the end of each semester to a maximum of (4) four students. Students are eligible to receive this award (2) two times while enrolled at Joliet Junior College.

The student must be enrolled in a minimum of (6) six credit hours at the time of application.

Current instructors will be contacted to provide an academic summary of coursework and grades up to the application deadline. Preference will be given to those students who are academically successful as well as being involved.

DIRECTIONS: Please complete the application on the back of this form and attach all required documents as outlined below before submitting. Everything must be legible. Applicants will be notified of their status.

**Materials must be submitted to the Office of Student Activities
by November 7, 2008 (fall semester) or April 3, 2009 (spring semester).**

The following information should be helpful in completing your application:

1. Complete Section 1: **Demographic Data.**
2. Complete Section 2: **Personal Statement with response to questions.**
3. Attach a **letter of recommendation** written by a faculty or staff member that speaks to your leadership qualities and experience in this area.
4. List the Leadership Institute sessions you attended **OR** Leadership Moments you participated in as part of Collegiate Club Council. A brief description of what you gained from these sessions should be included.
5. Attach your current semester's schedule of classes.

6. Your application must be received by **November 7, 2008 (fall semester)** or **April 3, 2009 (spring semester)**. *All requested documents, including letters of recommendation, must accompany the application when submitted to:*
