03.02.03 OUT OF DISTRICT RESIDENTS OF ILLINOIS

A person who resides in Illinois but is not a resident of Illinois Community College District 525, as previously defined in Board Policy 3.02.01 Residents of College District, is considered an out-of-district student and will be assessed the appropriate tuition. Out-of-district students shall not be required to pay higher tuition than that required for in-district students, provided these students comply with existing community college laws relative to cooperative agreements and joint educational agreements.

In 2017, the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB) took over the administration of the [Comprehensive Agreement Regarding the Expansion of Education Resources \(CAREER\) program](#). By the end of the spring semester of 2017, all 39 community college districts had signed on to the agreement and the agreement superseded all previous cooperative agreements. While in effect, the CAREER program eliminates the need for chargebacks. At which time a community college withdraws from the CAREER program, the chargeback process will be utilized in accordance with Board Policy 03.03.03 Partial Tuition Support.

Eligible active duty service members, veterans, and their dependents will be charged in-state tuition and fee amounts in accordance with all applicable state and federal regulations and guidance. Eligibility is defined by the regulating agency.
