Guaranteed Transfer Admission Agreement

Take advantage of this Guaranteed Transfer Admission Agreement and easily transfer into University of Wisconsin-Whitewater! JJC students can transfer up to 72 credits into UW-Whitewater.

Students who meet the following criteria will be guaranteed admission into University of Wisconsin-Whitewater:

1. Complete ENG 101 and ENG 103 with a passing grade to meet the English proficiency requirements of UW-Whitewater.
2. Earn a minimum of 24-30 transferable credits at JJC with a minimum GPA of 2.0 on all transferable coursework.
3. Enroll and complete general education coursework within three years of initial enrollment in the Guaranteed Transfer Admission Program with a maximum of 72 credits that will be applied to the bachelor's degree.
4. Graduate & enroll in University of Wisconsin-Whitewater!

Notes:

1. Courses numbered lower than the 100-level are included in the GPA calculation, but do not count towards graduation requirements at UW-Whitewater.
2. Regardless of major, a minimum of 25% of the major course units and 25% of the minor course units must be completed at UW-Whitewater.
3. A minimum of 30 units of UW-Whitewater coursework is required to qualify for an undergraduate degree. At least 15 of these 30 units must be taken at UW-Whitewater immediately prior to graduation.
4. It is recommended that students track their degree progress by working with their advisor at Joliet Junior College and UW-Whitewater.
5. An Associate in Art or Associate in Science degree from JJC will be considered to have fulfilled all of UW-Whitewater's general education requirements with the exception of the U.S. Racial/Ethnic Diversity requirement.
6. Incoming transfer students may apply for admission into the Honors Program if their cumulative GPA at UW-Whitewater is at least 3.4 and if they have earned at least 12 credits. Admittance is determined by the Honors Director.
7. Students must be admitted by April 1 to qualify for merit-based transfer scholarships.
