ACT and SAT Scores

Valid and qualifying ACT and SAT scores can be used for placement into college-level English and math courses. Students who meet any of the following ACT or SAT scores may not need to take a placement exam. ACT/SAT scores are valid for 48 months.

Important Information about using high school GPA for English and math placement:

- Must provide an official transcript showing 4 years (8 semesters) earning a C or higher in high school English and/or math.

- In order to use GPA for placement into English and math courses, a transcript with grades from both semesters within each year are required. Students waiting for their final grades are welcome to review JJC's other placement measures or prepare for placement testing if needed.
