DePaul Admission Partnership Program

Take advantage of the DePaul Admission Partnership Program (DAPP) and easily transfer into one of DePaul's bachelor's degree programs. Complete both an associate and a bachelor's degree while paying lower tuition rates at JJC for up to two years. JJC students may apply up to 66 semester hours to a bachelor's degree program.

Students who meet the following criteria will be eligible for the DePaul Admission Partnership Program:

1. Participate in the DAPP as early as possible, prior to completing 30 semesters hours of college level credit.
2. Apply for admission separately to each institution and indicate to both institutions that you wish to participate in the DAPP. Notify both schools of date of transfer and major.
3. Maintain good standing and satisfactory academic progress with a cumulative GPA of 2.0. Commerce and Education programs require a minimum GPA of 2.5.
4. Maintain continuous enrollment of at least 2 courses per term in a transfer degree program, excluding summer sessions.
5. Transfer to DePaul within a three-year period.

Notes:

1. As a requirement for participation in DAPP, students must provide each institution with a signed, written authorization to disclose his or her education records to the other institution.
2. Students participating in the DAPP must submit to DePaul an unofficial copy of their transcript at the conclusion of each semester. The final official transcript provided by JJC for the official DePaul admission decision must be consistent in content to any unofficial transcript submitted.
3. Students will be permitted to move from JJC to DePaul at any point during their progress towards their degree but not more than three years from the date of the initial participation in the DAPP.
4. Course work taken while participating in the DAPP is subject to DePaul's transfer credit policies.

Additional Information:

Transfer Student Scholarship:

DAPP students, who meet eligibility requirements, may earn a minimum scholarship award of \$2,000 per year upon enrollment at DePaul. DAPP students may also apply for the PTK scholarship and additional need-based assistance.

Note:

DePaul Admission Partnership Program is not a good fit for programs that require a significant amount of coursework that must be completed at DePaul during the first 2 years; therefore DAPP is not available to students who intended to enroll in School of Music and /or Theatre School programs.
