Per Title 38, Code of Federal Regulations, Sections 21.4253(d)(3) and 21.4254(C)(4) The Department of Veterans Affairs **requires** Joliet Junior College to evaluate all possible sources of credit for students utilizing GI Bill.

Joliet Junior College will award seven college credits (four credits of physical education, HPR 101, and a three credit health class, BIO 103) to any service member who **served a minimum of one year active duty**, and was discharged honorably.
